TODAY'S GAME – BUFFALO vs. COLUMBUS – SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 30, 2023

Tonight's game marks Buffalo's fifth of seven total preseason games after the Sabres earned wins in two of their first four. Today's matchup is being broadcast on WGR 550 AM in Western New York and a live stream is available on sabres.com.

After playing three games in as many nights from Sept. 26 to 28, Buffalo kicks off a preseason home-and-home series with the Columbus Blue Jackets, which concludes with a road matchup against the Blue Jackets on Oct. 4. The Sabres will round out their preseason schedule at KeyBank Center with a second preseason matchup against the Pittsburgh Penguins on Oct. 6.

Buffalo and Columbus have played 23 preseason games against each other all-time. The Sabres and Blue Jackets faced off in the 2022 preseason, with the Blue Jackets prevailing by a score of 4-1 in Columbus on Sept. 28, 2022. The Sabres are 12-11-0 in preseason contests against the Blue Jackets all-time. In their preseason history, the Sabres are 6-5-0 at Columbus and 4-4-0 against the Blue Jackets at home. Four of the 23 preseason games between the Sabres and Blue Jackets have been played at neutral site venues, with the Sabres going 2-2-0 in those games.

The Sabres and Blue Jackets will meet three times in the regular season, beginning with two matchups in Buffalo on Dec. 19 and Dec. 30. The two teams will conclude their regular-season series in Columbus on Feb. 23.

The Sabres are 169-174-53 all-time in the preseason, including a 56-38-7 preseason record since the 2005-06 season. These totals only include games against NHL opponents; the Sabres also defeated Adler Mannheim 8-3 in an exhibition game as part of the 2011 NHL Premiere Series.

Buffalo will open the regular season at home when they host the New York Rangers on Oct. 12. The Sabres will then begin their road schedule with a standalone trip to play the New York Islanders on Oct. 14. Following the first two games of their regular season, Buffalo will begin a four-game homestand consisting of matchups with Tampa Bay, Calgary, NY Islanders and Montreal from Oct. 17 to 23.

BLUE JACKETS OPEN EIGHT-GAME PRESEASON SCHEDULE: The Blue Jackets continue their eight-game preseason schedule this afternoon as they travel to face the Buffalo Sabres. The club opened up preseason play by with a doubleheader against the Pittsburgh Penguins (3-2 SOL at PIT, 4-3 OTW vs. PIT) on Sunday before falling 3-2 at St. Louis on Tuesday. - June 6 Acquired D Ivan Provorov as part of a three-team trade involving the Philadelphia Flyers and Los Angeles Kings in exchange for a first-round pick in the 2023 NHL Draft and a conditional second-round selection in either the 2024 or 2025 NHL Draft.
- June 9 Acquired D Damon Severson from the New Jersey Devils in exchange for a third-round pick in the 2023 NHL Draft.
- June 15 Signed C Josh Dunne to a one-year, two-way NHL/AHL contract extension.
- June 21 Signed RW Mathieu Olivier to a two-year contract extension through the 2024-25 season.
- June 23 Signed RW Carson Meyer to a one-year, two-way NHL/AHL contract extension.
- June 27 Sign RW Trey Fix-Wolansky to a two-year, two-way NHL/AHL contract extension through the 2024-25 season.
- June 30 Signed D Marcus Bjork to a one-year, two-way NHL/AHL contract extension.
- July 1 Signed C Adam Fantilli to a three-year entry level contract.

OFF-SEASON BLUE JACKETS HEADLINES

CHANGE BEHIND THE BENCH: The club will have a new leader behind the bench this season as Pascal Vincent was promoted to head coach on Sept. 17, 2023 after Mike Babcock resigned from the position. Vincent, who turned 52 on September 22, had joined the Blue Jackets as an associate coach in 2021. He spent the previous 10 seasons as a member of the Winnipeg Jets organization, including five as head coach of the American Hockey League's Manitoba Moose from 2016-21. The native of Laval, Quebec compiled a 155-139-31 record in 325 AHL games and was awarded the Louis A.R. Pieri Memorial Award (Coach of the Year) in 2017-18. Vincent also posted a 429-313-87 record in 829 games as head coach in the Quebec Major Junior Hockey League with the Cape Breton Screaming Eagles from 2000-08 and Montreal Juniors from 2008-11.

ADDING ON THE BLUELINE The club acquired a pair of veterans over a four-day span this off-season to boost the defensive core. CBJ acquired blueliner **Ivan Provorov** in a three-team trade with Philadelphia and Los Angeles on June 6th. The seventh overall pick in the 2015 NHL Draft – and one pick before All-Star defenseman Zach Werenski was selected by the Blue Jackets – notched 65-152-217 and 196 PIM, while averaging 24:05 TOI in 532 career games with the Flyers. The team then acquired defenseman **Damon Severson** in a trade from New Jersey after he signed an eight-year contract extension that runs through 2030-31 on June 9th. He joins the club after registering 58-205-263 and 388 PIM in 647 career games with the Devils since making his NHL debut in 2014-15.

HOBEY BAKER ADDITION: The Blue Jackets selected University of Michigan freshman Adam Fantilli third overall at the 2023 NHL Draft on June 28th and then signed him to a three-year entry-level contract on July 1. Fantilli racked up 30-35-65, 145 shots on goal and was +31 in 36 games at Michigan in 2022-23. He became the third freshman in NCAA history to win the Hobey Baker Award as the NCAA's top collegiate player, joining Paul Kairya (1993) and Jack Eichel (2015) after leading all college players in goals and points.

He was also named the NCAA Top Collegiate Rookie and Big Ten Freshman of the Year, NCAA First All-American Team and First-Team All-Big Ten.

AT THE DRAFT: The Blue Jackets selected eight players in the 2023 NHL Draft held at Bridgestone Arena in Nashville from June 28-29. The team drafted **Fantilli** in the first round third overall from the University of Michigan. Overall, the club selected six forwards, one defenseman and one goalie.

TRAVERSE CITY RECAP: Columbus captured the Prospect Tournament title at Traverse City, Michigan after winning two of its three games from September 14-17. The Blue Jackets started the tournament with a 7-3 victory over the Toronto Maple Leafs and 10-7 win over the Detroit Red Wings. The club concluded the tournament with a 6-3 loss to the Dallas Stars. RW **Jordan Dumais** led the tournament in goals and points with 4-4-8 in two games. C **Adam Fantilli** ranked second-T in goals, assists and points with 3-4-7 in two games, while D **Denton Mateychuk**, who served as captain for the Blue Jackets, led the way in assists with 0-7-7 in two contests.

2022-23 SEASON RECAP

COLUMBUS BLUE JACKETS COMPLETE 22ND NHL SEASON: The Columbus Blue Jackets completed their 22nd NHL season with a 25-48-9 record (59 pts./.360 pts. pct.)... The club finished eighth in the Metropolitan Division, 16th in the Eastern Conference and 31st in the NHL... Since the start of the 2012-13 season, the Blue Jackets have gone 398-343-89 (.533) with seven winning seasons and five Stanley Cup Playoffs berths during that span.

BLUE JACKETS AT HOME: The Blue Jackets went 16-23-2 (47 pts./.415) at home this past season, scoring 113 goals (2.76 per game) and allowing 159 goals (3.88) in 41 games, including a 5-1 loss to Colorado in Tampere, Finland as part of the 2022 NHL Global Series... In 22 seasons, Columbus is 427-338-102 (.551) in 867 home games.

COLUMBUS ON THE ROAD: Columbus went 9-25-7 (25 pts./.305) on the road this season, scoring 100 goals (2.44 per game) and allowing 170 goals (4.15) in 41 games, including a 6-3 loss vs. Colorado in Tampere, Finland as part of the 2022 NHL Global Series... In 22 NHL seasons, Columbus is 313-446-106 (.423) in 865 road games.

GOALS FOR/GOALS AGAINST: Goals For: The Blue Jackets scored 213 goals in 82 games (not including SO goals), which was an average of 2.60 goals per game (30th, NHL)... Columbus scored four or more goals (incl. SO goals) 24 times (21-2-1) and five or more on 13 occasions (13-0-0)... Goals Against: The Blue Jackets allowed 329 goals in 82 games, averaging 4.01 goals-against per game (31st, NHL), which was the most in club history (previous record: 297/3.62, 2021-22)... The team surrendered two goals or fewer in 15 games (9-5-1) and one goal or fewer in seven contests (6-1-0).

MISCELLANEOUS NEWS & NOTES: The Blue Jackets had the second-youngest roster in the NHL during the 2022-23 season with 19 players making their team debut and a franchise-record 11 players making their NHL debuts during the campaign... Columbus played 17 back-to-back sets during the 2022-23 season and posted an overall record of 9-22-2 with a 5-12-0 mark in first games and 4-10-2 in second contests... The Blue Jackets had four players score at least 20 goals this season, which was tied for the second-most in a single season in club history (five; 2018-19)... The club set a new team record with 563 man-games lost to injury (previous high was 508 in 2014-15)... A franchise-record 47 different players played in a game this season, including six goaltenders, surpassing the previous highs of 43 players (2003-04) and five goaltenders (2006-07 and 2008-09)... The Blue Jackets averaged 29.3 shots on goal per game (26th, NHL) and allowed 35.4 shots-against (31st, NHL)... The club averaged 16.22 blocked shots per game (4th, NHL; 1,343 total); 22.71 hits (15th, NHL; 1,880 total); 6.35 giveaways (4th-fewest, NHL; 526 total); 6.46 takeaways (23rd, NHL; 535 total); and won 48.6 percent of its faceoffs taken (23rd, NHL).

2022-23 PLAYER RECAP

GAUDREAU LEADS THE WAY: LW Johnny Gaudreau led the Blue Jackets in assists, points, shots, power play points, overtime goals, game-winning goals and games played (tied) and finished third-T in goals with 21-53-74, 220 shots, 24 PPP, three OTG and four GWG in 80 games in his first season with the team... Also led the club in multi-assist (14) and multi-point outings (20)... Registered the second-most OTG in a single-season in club history, trailing only Artemi Panarin (4 in 2018-19)... Reached the 70-point plateau for the fifth time in his career and became the sixth different player to accomplish the feat in a single season in club history... His 53 assists were the fourth-most in a single season in club history, while his 74 points were fifth-most... Set a new franchise record for the most multi-point outings by a player in their first year with the team, surpassing Artemi Panarin (19; 2017-18)... Tied the franchise record with a five-point game (2-3-5) on Mar. 14 at San Jose (sixth time)... Recorded a hat trick (3-0-3) while skating in his seventh career NHL All-Star Game - and first representing the Blue Jackets - on Feb. 4 at FLA Live Arena in Sunrise, Florida.

CAPTAIN BOONE JENNER: C Boone Jenner led the team in goals and ranked second-T in power play goals and third in points with 26-19-45 and seven power play goals in 68 contests... Longest-tenured Blue Jacket following his 10th season with the club, including his second as the team's captain, recorded 25-plus goals for the second time in his career... Posted the second-most goals and points in

a season in his career (30-19-49 in 2015-16)... Ranks second on the club's all-time list in games played, third in goals and fourth in points with 170-159-329 in 657 career games... Became the third player to play in 600 career games with the franchise on Nov. 4 vs. Colorado... Notched his 150th career Blue Jackets goal on Nov. 15 vs. Philadelphia, joining Rick Nash (289) and Cam Atkinson (213) to reach the milestone... Nominated by the Columbus chapter of the Professional Hockey Writers Association for the Bill Masterton Memorial Trophy - the award is given annually to the player who best exemplifies the qualities of perseverance, sportsmanship and dedication to hockey.

LAINE LIGHTS UP: LW Patrik Laine led the club in power play goals and points per game, ranked second in goals and points and finished third in assists despite missing 27 games as he finished with 22-30-52 and eight power play goals in 55 outings (.95 points per game)... Reached the 20-goal and 50-point plateaus for the sixth time in his career... Notched his 10th career hat trick - and second with the Blue Jackets - on Jan. 14 at Detroit, also recording his 11th multi-goal effort with the Blue Jackets, which is tied for the eighth-most in franchise history (Scott Hartnell and David Vyborny)... Registered points in nine of his last 10 games (5-9-14), including a six-game points streak from Feb. 28-Mar. 14 (4-4-8), prior to missing the final 12 contests of the campaign due to a triceps injury... Has averaged .97 points per game (48-60-108, 111 GP) over the past two seasons compared to .77 (150-121-271, 351 GP) in his first five campaigns.

MARCHENK-GOAL!: RW Kirill Marchenko set franchise records for most goals and power play goals (tied) by a rookie with 21-4-25, seven power play goals and three multi-goal games in 59 appearances... Tied for the NHL lead among rookies in power play goals (Anaheim's Mason McTavish) and ranked third in goals, trailing only Seattle's Matty Beniers (24) and Dallas' Wyatt Johnston (24)... Made his NHL debut on Dec. 6 at Pittsburgh after racking up 8-11-19 in 16 games with Cleveland (AHL)... Notched his first career NHL goal on Dec. 11 vs. Los Angeles... Became the sixth rookie in franchise history to register a hat trick with 3-0-3 on eight shots on Jan. 7 vs. Carolina... Recorded his 21st goal of the season with his first career overtime winner on Apr. 2 vs. Ottawa to surpass Pierre-Luc Dubois (20 in 2017-18) for most goals by a CBJ rookie in a campaign... Recorded the third-most points and fourth-most goals (tied), assists and game winners (tied) by a rookie in a single season in club history... Ranked third-T among NHL rookies in game-winning goals and fifth in points... Surpassed Rick Nash (39 pts. in 74 GP in 2002-03) for the third-most points by a rookie in a single-season in franchise history with an assist on Apr. 4 at Toronto... Registered a season-high four-game points streak from Oct. 20-Oct. 25 (3-1-4)... Notched his first career NHL goal on Oct. 22 vs. Pittsburgh.

BOQVIST LEADS CBJ DEFENSEMEN IN SCORING: D Adam Boqvist, who missed 30 games due to injury, set single-season career highs in assists and points with 5-19-24 in 46 games... Led the team's blueliners in assists, points and power play points (nine) and ranked second in goals... Set a new single-season career high with points in four consecutive games from Feb. 14-19 (2-3-5)... Has collected 15-30-45 in his last 89 games compared to 7-23-30 in his first 85 NHL games.

MISCELLANEOUS PLAYER NEWS & NOTES: C Jack Roslovic set a single-season career high in assists and posted the second-highest point total of his career (45 in 2021-22) with 11-33-44 in 77 contests...
