JETS NOTES

- » Win their second consecutive game to improve to an 8-3-0 record on the season
- » Improve to 3-2-0 against the Central Division and 4-3-0 at home
- » Move into first place in the Central Division and the Western Conference
- » Improve to a 6-1-0 record when scoring first this season
- » Set a new season high with six goals scored
- » Now rank second in the NHL with a +12 goal differential
- » Outshot Chicago 32-24, outshooting their opponent for the second time in a game this season
- » Went 3-for-3 on the penalty kill, snapping a three-game streak of allowing a power play goal

- » Remain first in the league with a 91.66% penalty kill
- » Won 30/53 faceoffs (56.6%) and have now won the faceoff battle in 8 of 11 games
- » Finish the first month of the season with an 8-3-0 record, tied for the second most October wins in franchise history
