GAME NOTES

THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW

- Tonight is the first of two games the Stars will play against the Blue Jackets this season. The two teams will face each other again on January 22 in Columbus.
- Tonight's matchup against the Blue Jackets marks the first of three consecutive games the Stars will play at home. It is their longest homestand until March 6 to 16 when the team will play six straight games at the American Airlines Center.
 - The team will also play in four consecutive home games in February, but the games are split by the Olympic break. Two will be played prior to the NHL's schedule pause (Feb. 2 vs. WPG, Feb. 4 vs. STL) and two will be played after NHL games resume (Feb. 26 vs. SEA, Feb. 28 vs. NSH).
- Dallas has scored 18 goals this season, ranking sixth in the NHL with 3.60 goals per game entering play Monday.

- Five Stars skaters have totaled at least six points this season: **Mikko Rantanen** (2-5—7), **Thomas Harley** (1-5—6), **Roope Hintz** (1-5—6), **Wyatt Johnston** (4-2—6) and **Jason Robertson** (2-4—6). Entering play Monday, Dallas, Toronto and Vegas were the only three teams this season to have at least five different skaters with six or more points.
- The Stars have gone 5-for-15 on the power play this season for a 33.3 percent success rate, which was tied for the third-best mark in the NHL entering play Monday.
- **Miro Heiskanen** is averaging 25:15 of ice time per game this season, which was the seventh-highest total in the NHL entering play Monday.
- **Adam Erne** has totaled 13 hits in two games played this season. Entering play Monday, his 42.02 hits per 60 were the second-best mark in the NHL, trailing on the Islanders' Marc Gattcomb (49.12).
- **Roope Hintz** enters tonight's game one goal shy of passing Danny Grant (176) for 15th-most goals in franchise history.
- **Esa Lindell** is one assist shy of surpassing Stephane Robidas (165) for 10th-most assists by a defenseman in franchise history.

DRIVING THE 'BUS

- Dallas is 43-25-8 all-time vs. Columbus, with a 22-13-2 mark on home ice.
- The Stars enter tonight's game having seven wins in their last 10 games against the Blue Jackets (7-3-0), also earning wins in their last two games played at American Airlines Center.
- **Mikko Rantanen** has tallied nine points (5-4—9) in his last five games played vs. Columbus. In all, **Rantanen** has 15 points (6-9—15) in 13 career games, averaging 1.15 points per game.
- **Matt Duchene** recorded 12 points (4-8—12) in 23 games with the Blue Jackets in 2018-19. In all, **Duchene** has recorded 28 points (9-19—28) in 43 career games vs. Columbus. **Duchene's** first goal with Dallas came in the club's 5-3 win over Columbus on Oct. 30, 2023.
- **Jason Robertson** enters tonight's matchup riding a four-game point streak (2-4—6) against the Blue Jackets. **Robertson** has tallied 13 points (6-7—13) in 14 career games vs. Columbus.
- **Wyatt Johnston** has six points (3-3—6) in six career games against the Blue Jackets, also entering tonight's contest riding a two-game point streak against them.
- **Thomas Harley** has four points (1-3—4) in four career games vs. Columbus, registering points in all but one game.
- **Tyler Seguin** has registered 15 points (10-5—15) in 22 career games against the Blue Jackets, including putting up a multi-point outing in his last meeting vs. Columbus on November 9, 2023 (1-1—2).
- **Mavrik Bourque** has recorded a point (1-1—2) in each of his two career games against the Blue Jackets.
- **Jake Oettinger** is 9-1-1 with a 2.07 goals-against average, .916 save percentage and one shutout in 11 career appearances against the Blue Jackets. His lone shutout vs. Columbus was a 2-1 save performance in Dallas' 5-0 victory on March 6, 2021.

GOING STREAKING

- Both **Wyatt Johnston** (4-2—6) and **Mikko Rantanen** (3-4—7) enter tonight's game riding a five-game point streak, tallying at least one point in each Stars game this season.
- Entering play Monday, their five-game point streaks were tied for the fifth-longest active point streaks in the NHL.
- If either or **Johnston** or **Rantanen** were to score a goal or notch an assist tonight, they would become the 12th skater in franchise history to begin a season with a six-game point streak according to NHL Stats, and the first to do so since Jamie Benn in 2015-16.
- If *both* of **Johnston** and **Rantanen** were to record a point tonight, it would mark the fourth time in franchise history, and the first time since the Stars relocated to Dallas, that two or more Stars skaters began a season with congruent six-game point streaks according to NHL Stats.
 - Previously, Neal Broten and Dino Ciccarelli both began the 1986-87 season with six-game point streaks, Al MacAdam, Steve Payne and Bobby Smith all had points in six straight to begin the 1979-80 season and Ernie Hicke and Dennis Hextall both began the 1975-76 season with a point in six consecutive games.
- **Johnston's** current five-game point streak is already tied for the longest from the start of a season in his career, after also beginning the 2024-25 season with a five-game point streak.
 - With an assist against the Blues, **Johnston** became the second player in Stars/North Stars history to record a season-opening five-game point streak in consecutive campaigns according to NHL Stats, joining Brad Richards (5 GP in 2009-10 & 2010-11).
- The 2025-26 campaign is the fourth time in **Rantanen's** career that he has begun a season with a point in at least five consecutive games after also doing so in 2022-23, 2021-22, 2019-20 and 2018-19.

THE MOOSE IS LOOSE

- **Mikko Rantanen** has tallied seven points (3-4—7) through the Stars' first five games of the season and enters tonight's game leading the team in scoring.
- **Rantanen** has recorded at least one point in each of the five games Dallas has played this season. Entering play Monday, his five-game point streak was tied for the fifth-longest active point streak in the NHL.
- A goal or an assist tonight would give **Rantanen** points in six straight games to begin a season for the third time in his career after also doing so in 2018-19 and 2019-20.
- The 2025-26 campaign marks the sixth time in his career that **Rantanen** has had at least seven points through his first five games played of a season, also doing so in 2024-25 (4-6—10), 2023-24 (4-4—8), 2022-23 (3-6—9), 2019-20 (4-5—9) and 2018-19 (1-7—8).

- **Rantanen** had three points (1-2—3) in the season opener to make the 2024-25 campaign the fourth consecutive season opener that he had at least three points after scoring a hat trick in 2024, recording two goals and two assists in 2023 and notching four assists in 2022.
- **Rantanen** enters tonight's game three goals shy of totaling 300 career goals. When he reaches the milestone, he will become:
 - The fourth Finnish skater in NHL history to score 300 NHL goals, joining Teemu Selane (684), Jari Kurri (601) and Olli Jokinen (321).
 - The second player selected in the 2015 NHL Draft to score 300 NHL goals, joining Edmonton's Connor McDavid (361).
 - The 38th active skater to score 300 NHL goals.
- Since the start of the 2016-17 season – **Rantanen's** first full NHL year – his 297 goals are the eighth-most in the NHL and his 712 points (297-415—712) rank 10th.
- Thirty of those 297 goals have come from 10 hat tricks. Since the start of the 2016-17 season, only David Pastrnak (19), Alex Ovechkin (17), Auston Matthews (13), Connor McDavid (12) and Patrik Laine (11) have scored more hat tricks than **Rantanen's** 10.
 - His 10 hat tricks trail only Jari Kurri (23), Teemu Selane (22) and Laine (11) for the most by a Finnish skater in NHL history.

JOHNNY B. GOODE

- **Wyatt Johnston** has begun the season with a five-game point streak, totaling six points (4-2—6) in Dallas' first five games played of the season. Entering play Monday, his five-game point streak was tied for the fourth-longest active such streak in the NHL.
 - **Johnston's** six points are the most he's totaled through his first five games played of a season in his career.
- A goal or an assist tonight would give **Johnston** points in six consecutive games to begin a season for the first time in his career.
- **Johnston** scored in each of the Stars' first four games of the season, making him the fifth skater in franchise history to begin a season with a four-game goal streak. He and Minnesota's Matt Boldy were the only two skaters this year to score in each of their first four games played.
 - Entering play Monday, **Johnston's** four goals were tied for 10th in the NHL.
- Two of **Johnston's** goals this season have been scored on the power play, which was tied for the fifth-most in the NHL entering play Monday.
- With his goal against the Jets, **Johnston** became the ninth player in franchise history – and the first since Sergei Zubov (1996-97 to 2005-06; 9) – to record a point in at least four consecutive season openers according to NHL Stats.

BIKER GANG

- Defenseman **Thomas Harley** enters tonight's game tied for second on the team in scoring with six points (4-2—6) in five games played. His six points were tied for third among all NHL defensemen entering play Monday.
- **Harley** has also totaled a team-leading 16 blocked shots this year, which tied for seventh in the NHL entering play Monday.
- **Harley** began the 2025-26 season with a point in four consecutive games, marking the first time in his career that he began a season with a four-game point streak. It was also the third time in his career that he recorded a point in four consecutive games.
- **Harley** was one of four NHL defensemen to begin the 2025-26 season with a point in each of his first four games played, joining the Hurricanes' Shayne Gostisbehere (1-6—7) and Alexander Nikishin (1-3—4), and the Islanders Matthew Schaefer (1-3—4).
- With two assists in the season opener, **Harley** became the 25th defenseman in franchise history to have two or more points in a season-opening game according to NHL Stats and the first to do so since **Miro Heiskanen** (1-1—2) in the 2021 season opener.
- **Harley** had two points again the following game against the Avalanche, scoring a goal and adding an assist. His goal was the 33rd of his career, which is second most by a Stars/North Stars defenseman prior to his 200th contest behind Brad Maxwell (34) according to NHL Stats.
- **Harley** enters tonight's game three goals shy of surpassing Barry Gibbs (35) and Mark Tinordi for the 15th-most goals by a defenseman in franchise history. Gibbs and Tinordi both scored 35 goals in 375 regular-season games with the Stars.
- **Harley** played in his 200th NHL game in the Stars' game against the Wild. In reaching the milestone, **Harley** became the 24th skater and fourth defenseman drafted in 2019 to play in 200 NHL games, and the 39th defenseman in franchise history to play in 200 games for the Stars.

ROBO ON THE GOGO

- **Jason Robertson** has totaled six points (2-4—6) through the team's first five games of the season and enters tonight's contest tied for second on the team in scoring.
- **Robertson** tallied two assists against the Canucks on Oct. 16 to bring his career point total to 400 (170-230—400). In reaching the milestone he became:
 - The 17th player in franchise history to record 400 points with the team.
 - The third-fastest player in franchise history to record 400 points with the club.
 - The fourth player selected in the 2017 NHL draft to total 400 career points.
- **Robertson** became the fifth player in Stars/North Stars history to hit the 400-point milestone in 400 games or fewer according to NHL Stats, following Bobby Smith (332 GP), Neal Broten (367 GP), Dino Ciccarelli (387 GP) and Mike Modano (392 GP). His 400th career point came in his 378th regular-season game played.
- When **Robertson** has been on the ice during 5-on-5 play this season, the Stars are outscoring their opponents 5-0 according to Natural Stat Trick. His plus-5 5-on-5 goal differential is the best mark on the Stars roster this season.

IRON SHARPENS IRON

- The Stars have two players on their roster that have played in at least 100 consecutive regular-season games: **Jason Robertson** (297) and **Wyatt Johnston** (251).
- **Robertson's** 297-game Iron Man streak was the eighth-longest active such streak in the NHL entering play Monday.
- **Johnston** has not missed a regular-season game since making his debut in the 2022-23 season opener on Oct. 13, 2022, making him one of 26 players in NHL history to begin their NHL career by playing in at least 250 consecutive games according to NHL Stats. Entering play Monday, it was tied for the 17th-longest active Iron Man streak in the NHL.
- **Johnston** was one of 21 players to appear in at least 246 regular-season games from 2022-23 to 2024-25. Only **Will Borgen** (248) and **Charlie Coyle** (247) appeared in more.
 - **Borgen** (84) and **Coyle** (83), who were traded midseason, both played in more than 82 regular-season games in 2024-25.

FIRST THING'S FIRST

- Dallas opened the 2025-26 season with 12 former first-round picks on its roster; **Lian Bichsel** (DAL; 2022), **Mavrik Bourque** (DAL; 2020), **Matt Duchene** (COL; 2009), **Radek Faksa** (DAL; 2012), **Thomas Harley** (DAL; 2019), **Miro Heiskanen** (DAL; 2017), **Wyatt Johnston** (DAL; 2021) **Nils Lundkvist** (NYR; 2018), **Jake Oettinger** (DAL; 2017), **Mikko Rantanen** (COL; 2015), **Tyler Seguin** (BOS; 2010) and **Sam Steel** (ANA; 2016)
- **Tyler Seguin** is the highest drafted player on Dallas' roster, selected by Boston with the second-overall pick in the 2010 NHL Draft. **Seguin** leads all 2010 draft picks in career scoring (812) and ranks second in both goals (361) and assists (451).
- There are three sets of Stars skaters that were taken with the same pick in different years: **Matt Duchene** and **Miro Heiskanen** were both taken with the third-overall pick, **Duchene** by Colorado in 2009 and **Heiskanen** by Dallas in 2017. **Sam Steel** and **Mavrik Bourque** were both drafted 30th-overall – **Steel** by Anaheim in 2016 and **Bourque** by Dallas in 2020. Finally, Dallas selected both **Thomas Harley** and **Lian Bichsel** with the 18th overall pick, **Harley** in 2019 and **Bichsel** in 2022.
- Three additional Stars draft picks are on Dallas' opening night roster this year: **Roope Hintz** (2015; 2nd round), **Esa Lindell** (2012; 3rd round) and **Jason Robertson** (2017; 2nd round).

2024-25 REGULAR SEASON RECAP

- The Stars finished the 2024-25 regular season with a 50-26-6 record, ranking in the top five in the NHL this year in wins (tied fourth), points (fifth), goals for (275, tied third), goals for per game (3.35, tied third) and penalty kill (82.0 percent, tied fourth).
- The 2024-25 campaign marked the second straight year that Dallas had finished the regular season with at least 50 wins and the third consecutive year that the team concluded the regular season with a points percentage above .640.
- The 2024-25 season also sits near the top in the franchise record book in terms of single-season success with the team's 50 wins tying for the fourth-most in franchise history.
- The team's regular-season success last year came in spite of logging 190-man games lost to injury, which includes significant stretches playing without **Tyler Seguin** (62 games), **Miro Heiskanen** (32 games), **Nils Lundkvist** (40 games), **Mason Marchment** (20 games) and others.

ANNIVERSARY GAME NIGHT #1

The Blue Jackets welcomed back the organization's first head coach Dave King along with four former players from the inaugural 2000-01 season for the first of five 25th Anniversary Celebration games on Saturday night against Tampa Bay. Prior to puck drop vs. the Lightning, the club recognized King, along with defenseman Rostislav Klesla, forward Kevin Dineen, goaltender Ron Tugnutt and defenseman Jean-Luc Grand-Pierre. The game marked the first event in a season-long series spotlighting notable alumni and moments that have defined the Blue Jackets' 25 years in the National Hockey League.

ATKINSON RETIRES A BLUE JACKET

Cam Atkinson signed a one-day contract on Thursday morning that allows him to officially retire from the NHL as a member of the Blue Jackets. The club honored the forward prior to the club's game against the Avalanche with a final lap around the ice and introduced alongside the starting lineup. The Riverside, Connecticut native was selected in the 6th round, 157th overall, in the 2008 NHL Draft and posted 213-189-402 in 627 contests while playing in 10 of his 13 NHL campaigns as a Jacket. He ranks second on the club's all-time list in goals, points, game-winning goals (42) and shots on goal (1,883).

BLUE JACKETS NOTES

FINAL STRETCH OF OCTOBER

The Blue Jackets play seven of their games in the month of October against teams that made the 2025 Stanley Cup Playoffs, including six-straight from Oct. 11-24, and have posted a 2-2-0 record in the first four against these clubs. The club is 1-1-0 on the road in 2025-26 and will play three of its next four games away from Nationwide Arena. Following Tuesday's game at Dallas, Columbus will then play its first and second of 15 back-to-back games on Oct. 24 (vs. Washington) and 25 (at Pittsburgh) before playing Oct. 28 (at Buffalo) and Oct. 29 (vs. Toronto). The Jackets wrapped up its first homestand of the season last week with a 1-2-0 record.

GOALS GALORE

Columbus has outscored opponents 11-5 in five-on-five play with the five goals against the fewest allowed by any team in the NHL. The club was the first team to notch a seven-goal effort with their 7-4 win over Minnesota on Oct. 11, later matched by Anaheim that night. The Jackets notched four seven goal games in 2024-25 and led the NHL with 16 contests of six-plus goals during the campaign. Adam Fantilli's goal to make it 6-3 in the third period at Minnesota on Oct. 11 was the 5,000th in franchise regular season history.

HOME SWEET HOME

The Blue Jackets wrapped up their three-game homestand on Saturday night with a 3-2 victory over Tampa Bay for their first win at Nationwide Arena this season. The club fell to New Jersey on Oct. 13 (2-3) and Colorado on Oct. 16 (1-4). CBJ split their two-game (1-1-0) road trip to start the 2025-26 season. The club tied for the highest home point total in team history last season with a 26-10-5 record (57 pts./695) and ranked eighth-T in the league in total home points and points percentage. The Jackets also set franchise records and led the NHL in home goals and goals-for per game at 161 (3.93 per game). Columbus holds a 470-367-112 (.554) record in 949 games at Nationwide Arena in franchise history.

NEW JACKETS

Three new Blue Jackets made their team debut in the club's season opener on Oct. 9 at Nashville. The club acquired forwards **Charlie Coyle** and **Miles Wood** from Colorado in a trade on June 27 before signing forward **Isac Lundestrom** to a two-year contract on July 1. **Coyle**, who notched 189-296-485 in 950 career NHL games in 13 NHL campaigns with the Avalanche, Boston Bruins and Minnesota Wild, notched his first points with Columbus on Saturday at Minnesota with an assist. **Wood** scored his first goal in a Blue Jackets uniform at Minnesota, he has posted a career mark of 91-91-182 in 513 career outings with the Avalanche and New Jersey Devils prior to this season. **Lundestrom**, in his eighth NHL season, collected 35-49-84 in 337 career games with the Anaheim Ducks since making his debut in 2018-19.

MARCHY MADNESS

RW **Kirill Marchenko's** five goals are the most scored through the first five games of a season in franchise history, surpassing the previous best of four recorded by Boone Jenner (2021-22, 23-24) Johnny Gaudreau (2022-23), Sonny Milano (2017-18) and Rick Nash

(2008-09). His five goals scored this season rank seventh-T in the NHL. With his goal last Monday vs. New Jersey, he became the second skater in club history to score four goals in the first three games of a season (Sonny Milano, 4 in 2017-18). He scored his fourth-career hat trick on Oct. 11 at Minnesota to give him the third-most in franchise history, trailing only Cam Atkinson (6) and Rick Nash (5). It also marked his 10th career multi-goal game, which are the most among all Blue Jackets skaters since making his debut in 2022-23. He set a single-season career high with four in 2024-25. His first goal of the game at Minnesota was scored seven seconds into the second period, the fastest goal to start a period in franchise history (prev: 9 seconds into 2nd period, Patrik Laine on Feb. 17, 2022 at CHI). The Barnaul, Russia native is the first player in CBJ history to post three-straight 20-goal campaigns to start their career, while also becoming the third skater to tally 30 goals and 70 points in a season (Nash, 2008-09; Foligno, 2014-15) in 2024-25 with a career-high 31-43-74 and +29 in 79 GP.

JENNER JOINS THE 200 CLUB

CBJ captain C **Boone Jenner** scored his 200th career goal on Oct. 11 at Minnesota to join Cam Atkinson (213) and Rick Nash (289) as the only three players in franchise history to reach the milestone. His 1-2-3 effort also marked the 81st multi-point game of his career which tied Atkinson for the second-most in franchise history, as well as his 12th three-point game tying Ray Whitney for the seventh-most in CBJ history. The team's captain since 2020-21, he is the all-time club leader in games played with 745 and has collected 200-186-386 in 13 seasons with the Blue Jackets since making his debut on Oct. 4, 2013. He notched 7-12-19 in 26 games played during the 2024-25 season after missing the first 56 contests with a shoulder injury.

ZACH ATTACK

D **Zach Werenski**, ranks second in the NHL this season in time on ice per game at 26:39 and leads league blueliners in shots on goal (22), while ranking third-T in plus/minus rating (+6). He scored his first goal and assisted on two others for his first three-point (1-2-3) effort, and 16th of career, of the campaign on Oct. 11 at Minnesota. The outing tied David Vyborny for the fourth-most three-point games in Blue Jackets history (16), while also giving him his 80th career multi-point outing, one behind Jenner and Atkinson for second-most (Nash, 137). The blueliner entered the 2025-26 campaign as the franchise's all-time leader in goals, assists and points by a defenseman and sits third on the all-time points list.

The 2024-25 Norris Trophy runner-up, he set the single-season franchise record among defensemen in goals, assists and points for the second consecutive season while also tying the club record for assists in a season (Panarin, 59 in 2018-19) with 23-59-82 in 81 GP. He also set a franchise record and tied the third-longest home points streak by a defenseman in NHL history with points in 22-straight home contests from Nov. 1-Feb. 22 (14-27-41). The Grosse Pointe, Michigan native led the NHL in ice time (26:45) and ranked third in shots on goal (298), while leading league blueliners in shots and even-strength goals (17), ranking second in goals, points, power play goals (tied, 5), and even strength points (54) as well as fourth in assists during the 2024-25 campaign.
