THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW

The Sabres have earned two straight wins over the Flames.

A win tonight would mark Buffalo's first winning streak of three or more games against Calgary since the team won four in a row against the Flames from March 18, 2000 to Nov. 23, 2001.

A win would also give the Sabres four straight victories in Calgary for the first time since they did so from Nov. 16, 1991 to

Oct. 27, 1993.

Rasmus Dahlin has recorded 15 assists in his last 13 games, including at least one in back-to-back games.

Dahlin has posted 17 points (3+14) in his last 14 road games, including at least one assist in each of his last five.

Dahlin is two assists away from tying Mike Ramsey for the second-most assists (256) by a Sabres defenseman all-time.

Dahlin has recorded 72 goals in his career, one shy of tying Ramsey (73) for the second-most all-time among all Buffalo defensemen.

Among all NHL defensemen this season, Dahlin ranks sixth in points per game (0.87) and eighth in assists per game (0.72).

In his last 10 road contests, **Jack Quinn** has registered 10 points (6+4).



In his last 13 games, Jason Zucker has recorded 14 points (8+6).

Zucker has notched at least one point in seven of his last eight road games and he has recorded 12 points (8+4) in that

Tage Thompson has posted 14 points (5+9) in his last 13 games and he is riding a four-game point streak (2+3).

A point in tonight's game would give

Thompson his third point streak of five or more games this season.

ON THIS DATE

The Sabres are 10-9- all-time on January 23.

January 23, 1984: The Sabres wrap up a franchise-record 10-game winning streak on the way to an 11-0-2 January with a 5-3 win at Boston.

January 23, 2023: Owen Power scores 56 seconds into overtime as the Sabres top the Stars 3-2.



FLAME THROWERS

Tage Thompson is riding a six-game point streak against Calgary and he has recorded seven points (5+2) in that span.

Thompson has tallied one goal in four consecutive games against the Flames and a goal tonight would give him sole possession of the second-longest goal streak by a Sabres skater against Calgary all-time (Rick Martin; six games; March 10, 1979 to April 1, 1980).

In his last five games against Calgary, **Rasmus Dahlin** has posted six points (1+5).

JJ Peterka has recorded one point in three consecutive games against Calgary (2+1).

Ukko-Pekka Luukkonen has earned a win in back-to-back games against the Flames and he made 56 saves on 59 shots in that span.

A win in tonight's game would give **Luukkonen** the longest winning streak by a Sabres goaltender against the Flames since Dominik Hasek won five straight against Calgary from Oct. 22, 1997 to Nov. 13, 2000.
