

Signed by the Rangers as a free agent on July 1, 2023, Pitlick finished the 2022-23 season with 16 points (7G, 9A) in 61 games for the St. Louis Blues last season, reaching his 100th career career point with a goal on March 12, 2023 vs. Vegas. The 6-foot-2, 200-pound center has collected 105 points (55G, 50A) in 386 career NHL contests with the Blues, Montreal Canadiens, Calgary Flames, Arizona Coyotes, Philadelphia Flyers, Dallas Stars, and Edmonton Oilers. Originally selected by Edmonton in the second round (31st overall) of the 2010 NHL Draft, Pitlick has registered 100 or more hits in three of the last six seasons, including 103 with St. Louis last year.
