SAN DIEGO has earned standing points in five of their last six games (4-1-1) and 11 of the last 17 overall (9-6-2).

GLENN GAWDIN leads San Diego in goals (12) and ranks third among team skaters in points (12-10=22). Gawdin recorded a season high five game point streak (4-1=5) Jan. 10-21.

CALLE CLANG earned his fifth win of the season Jan. 23 vs. Abbotsford, stopping 24-of-25 shots and imporving to 5-7-4 with a 3.18 GAA and .896 SV% on the season. Clang has helped San Diego earn standing points in all off his last five starts (3-0-2).

TREVOR CARRICK ranks tied sixth among league defensemen in assists (20) and tied for eleventh in points (5-20=25). Carrick co-leads the Gulls in assists and ranks second in points.

ANDREW AGOZZINO skated in his 700th career AHL game Jan. 23 vs. Abbotsford. Agozzino leads the Gulls in points (8-20=28) and co-leads in assists and PPG (4).

PAVOL REGENDA recorded his 11th goal of the season Jan. 23 vs. Abbotsford to rank second among San Diego leaders in goals and eighth in points (11-3=14).

YEGOR SIDOROV ranks tied for second in the WHL in goals (35), ranks second in GWG (8), third in PPG (12) and tied for 15th in points (35-22=57). He leads Saskatoon in goals, PPG and GWG while ranking second on the team in scoring and fourth in assists. Sidorov is currently averaging 1.36 points per game and has 14-13=27 points through his last 20 games.

CAREY TERRANCE ranks tied for second among OHL leaders in SHG (4) and tied for ninth in goal scoring (24). He also leads the Erie Otters in goals and SHG, while ranking third in points (24-14=38). Terrance has 6-2=8 points through his last nine games and is averaging 1.12 points per game.

RODWIN DIONICIO ranks tied for fourth among OHL defensemen in goals (13) and tied for eighth in points (13-22=35). He also ranks second among Saginaw blueliners in points and goals, while ranking third in assists. Dionicio is currently riding a four-game point streak (2–3=5) and is averaging 1.25 points per game this season.

CONNOR HVIDSTON ranks tied for second among Swift Current leaders in goals (19), tied for fifth in points (19-17=36). Hvidston has 7-9=16 points his last 12 games and is averaging 1.20 points per game.

CUTTER GAUTHIER ranks tied for third among NCAA leaders in goals (17) and tied for 13th in scoring (17-13=30). He leads Boston College in goals, while ranking third among Eagles leaders in points and fourth in assists. Gauthier is currently riding a career-best 11-game point streak (9-10=19). He has scored 4-3=7 points with a +5 rating in his first four games with B.C. after helping Team USA to a gold medal at the 2024 World Junior Championship and recorded his first hat trick of the season and fourth multi-goal game (3-0=3).

SAM COLANGELO ranks second among Western Michigan leaders in goals (15) and PPG (6), while ranking third in points (15-13=28) and fourth in assists. He is currently riding a nine-game point streak (8-8=16).
