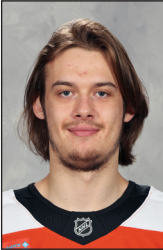

TOP NOTES

With his two-point performance (1+1), **Alex Tuch** extended his point streak against the Flyers (2+4) to four games and he has registered 11 points (5+6) in his last seven games against Philadelphia.

As a result of his assist on **Tuch's** goal, **Jason Zucker** set a new single-season career high in assists (32). **Zucker's** 24 primary assists this season were the most among all Sabres forwards.

With three blocked shots tonight, **Tuch** set the single-season NHL record (stat tracked since 2005-06) for the most blocked shots by a forward (113). He is one of 10 forwards who have registered 100 or more blocked shots in a single season since 2005-06.

Peyton Krebs' goal marked his 10th of the season, the most in a single season in his career. The goal was the second shorthanded tally of his career, and his first since Jan. 17, 2023 at Chicago. Buffalo's 10 shorthanded goals this season are the most by the Sabres in a single season since 2005-06 (10).

Tuch registered the primary assist on **Krebs'** goal and his nine shorthanded points this season (6+3) are tied with Michael Peca (twice) for the third-most shorthanded points in a single season by a Sabres skater all-time. Only Don Luce (13 in 1974-75) and Craig Ramsay (12 in 1974-75) have recorded more in a season with Buffalo.

Including his two points (1+1) tonight, **Jack Quinn** has notched eight points (5+3) in his last five games against Philadelphia.

Ryan McLeod tallied three points tonight (1+2) and he has now recorded at least one point in each of the three games he has played against the Flyers as a member of the Sabres. **McLeod** has posted seven total points in that span (2+5).

With his assist on **Quinn's** goal, **JJ Peterka** matched the longest assist streak against Philadelphia by a Sabres skater all-time (Gilbert Perreault; Jan. 31, 1974 to Feb. 20, 1975; six games).

With his two points tonight (1+1), **Peterka** finished the season tied with **Tage Thompson** for the lead among all Sabres forwards in multi-point games (16) this season.
