TOP NOTES

Zach Benson's first-period goal gave him three points (2+1) in his last two games. It marked the third time he has registered one goal in back-to-back games in his career.

With his goal, **Tage Thompson** became the first Sabres skater to record five or more home point streaks of at least seven games since Pat LaFontaine recorded his fifth with Buffalo from March 21 to April 16, 1995 (seven games; 8+4).

Thompson has recorded 11 points (6+5) during his current seven-game home point streak.

Thompson is now riding a six-game point streak against Calgary and he has recorded seven points (5+2) in that span, including at least one goal in four consecutive games against the Flames.

Rasmus Dahlin's assist on **Thompson's** goal gave him 235 assists in his career, which moved him past Alexei Zhitnik and gave him sole possession of third place all-time in assists by a Sabres defenseman.

Dahlin has notched nine points (2+7) in his last seven contests, including at least one point in three straight games (1+3). In his last five games against the Flames, **Dahlin** has registered six points (1+5).

JJ Peterka also tallied an assist on **Thompson's** goal and he has now registered seven points (2+5) in his last seven games. He has recorded at least one point in three consecutive games (2+3). **Peterka's** game-winning shootout goal marked the first shootout goal of his career.

Ukko-Pekka Luukkonen stopped all three Calgary shooters in the shootout, which marked the third time he has made three or more saves and allowed no goals in a shootout in his career. He last did so on Feb. 25, 2024 vs. Carolina (four saves). He is one of four Sabres goalies who have done so multiple times (Jhonas Enroth, 3; Ryan Miller, 15; Linus Ullmark, 4).

The Sabres have recorded three or more goals and held their opponents to two or fewer goals in three consecutive games, their longest such streak since they did so from Dec. 13 to 19, 2022 (four games).

Bowen Byram (32:34) registered more time on ice in a single game than any NHL skater this season. He is the sixth skater in Sabres franchise history to log 32 or more minutes in a single game and he is the first since Rasmus Ristolainen on Feb. 6, 2018 (32:39) to do so.
