THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW

The Sabres have earned a win in back-to-back games and a win today would give them their second three-game winning streak of the season.

Rasmus Dahlin has notched eight points (2+6) in his last six games, including at least one point in back-to-back games (1+2).

Dahlin (234 assists) is one assist away from passing Alexei Zhitnik and gaining sole possession of third place all-time in assists by a Sabres defenseman.

Tage Thompson is riding a six-game home point streak and he has registered 10 points (5+5) in that span.

If he records a point in today's game, Thompson would become the first Sabres skater to record five or more home point streaks of at least 7 games since Pat LaFontaine recorded his fifth from March 21 to April 16, 1995 (seven games; 8+4).

In his last 11 games, Jason Zucker has posted 11 points (3+8).

Zucker has recorded at least one point in each of his last six home games (3+4), the longest home point streak of his career.



Alex Tuch is riding a three-game point streak and he has registered three points (1+2) in that span.

JJ Peterka has registered six points (2+4) in his last six games.

Ryan McLeod has notched four points (0+4) in his last four games.

In his last three games, Ukko-Pekka

Luukkonen has made 83 saves on 87 shots (.954).



FLAME THROWERS

Tage Thompson is riding a five-game point streak against Calgary and he has recorded six points (4+2) in that span.

In his last four games against the Flames, **Rasmus Dahlin** has registered five points (1+4).

JJ Peterka has recorded one goal in back-to-back games against Calgary.

Dylan Cozens (1+3) and **Alex Tuch** (3+1) have each posted four points in their last four games against the Flames.

The Sabres are 6-9-4 all-time on November 9.

November 9, 2000: Maxim Afinogenov and Jason Woolley each record two assists as the Sabres defeat the Islanders 3-0.

November 9, 2005: Thomas Vanek scores twice, including his first career NHL goal, and adds an assist against the Carolina Hurricanes.

THE KIDS ARE ALRIGHT

Among all NHL defensemen age 25 or younger, Bowen Byram (23 years old) and Owen Power (22 years old) are tied for first in goals (3) and even-strength goals (3).



Rasmus Dahlin (24 years old) is tied for eighth in goals (2) and tied for sixth in even-strength goals (2) in that group.

Dahlin (10 points) ranks third and Byram and Power (9 points) are tied for fourth among all NHL defensemen age 25 or younger in points.

Dahlin (24:07), Byram (21:09) and Power (21:03) rank first, second and third, respectively, in time on ice per game among all Sabres skaters.

Dahlin ranks fifth among all NHL defensemen age 25 or younger in total time on ice (337:32).
