MATCHUP NOTES

- Columbus has earned points in 12 of the last 16 meetings in the series dating back to Mar. 31, 2019 (9-4-3).
- CBJ had their eight-game road points streak (5-0-3) snapped in the most recent meeting at KeyBank Center on Feb.
- Four of the past five overall meetings have been decided by a single goal. Five of the last eight at Buffalo have been decided by a single goal with four decided in overtime.
- The Blue Jackets have converted on 5-of-13 power play opportunities in the last eight overall meetings (38.5 pct.).
- The club has killed off all nine Buffalo power play chances over the last five matchups.
- RW Kirill Marchenko has 4-3-7 in eight career outings, including assists in his past three games (1-3-4).
- D Zach Werenski has 1-14-15 in 19 career GP against the Sabres and has points in six of last seven contests (1-8-9).



JACKET TO WATCH - C SEAN MONAHAN

Has posted 9-14-23 with 5 multi-point efforts in 24 career GP. Has collected points in last 3 contests at Buffalo (1-2-3) as well as 7 of last 8 at KeyBank Center (2-7-9).



SABRE TO WATCH - D RASMUS DAHLIN

Has 4-14-18 with points in 11 of 16 career GP against the Blue Jack ets. Collected assists in all three contests of the 2024-25 series



(1-2-3). Has points in 6-of-8 home contests (2-7-9).

TEAM NOTES

- Columbus won its third-straight road contest with a 5-4 SO win at Pittsburgh on Saturday. The club has started a campaign 3-1-0 on the road for the fourth time in franchise history (also 2010-11, 2017-18 and 2018-19).
- CBJ have outscored opponents 17-11 away from Nationwide Arena with the 4.25 GF/GP the third-highest in the NHL.
- The Blue Jackets split their first of three consecutive back-to-back sets with a 5-1 loss to Washington on Oct. 24 and 5-4 SO win at Pittsburgh on Oct. 25. CBJ play the second of 15 back-to-back sets of the season Tuesday at Buffalo and Wednesday vs. Toronto. The club finishes off the stretch on Nov. 1 vs. St. Louis and Nov. 2 at the NY Islanders.
- CBJ have outshot opponents in six of the eight contests this season and rank fourth in the NHL in shots/game (32.9).
 - The Jackets have outscored opponents 18-11 during 5-on-5 play with the 11 goals allowed the fewest in the NHL in 2025-26.

PLAYER NOTES

- C Charlie Coyle has recorded points in two of the last three contests (1-2-3) after notching his first as a Jacket on Oct. 24. He sits one assist shy of 300 for his NHL career (190-299-489, 958 GP).
- RW Kirill Marchenko collected an assist on Saturday and has recorded points in six of the eight games this season (5-3-8). He has notched three game-winners (two in regulation, SO GDG on Saturday) in 2025-26.
- G Elvis Merzlikins has won his first three road contests, joining Montreal's Jakub Dobes with a 3-0-0 away from home in 2025-26. He earned his 97th career win on Saturday to surpass Steve Mason for second on the club's all-time wins list.
- C Sean Monahan collected an assist for the third-straight game on Saturday and sits two points from 600 for his NHL career (263-335-598, 826 GP). He would become the fourth player from the 2013 NHL Draft class to reach the mark, joining C Nathan MacKinnon (1,029 points), C Aleksander Barkov (782 points) and C Elias Lindholm (611 points).
- LW Dmitri Voronkov stretched his points streak to four-straight (3-2-5) with two goals at the Penguins and has tallied points in seven of the Blue Jackets' eight games this season (5-4-9).
