

Signed by the Rangers as a free agent on July 1, 2023, Brouillard spent the 2022-23 season with the American Hockey League's San Diego Gulls, where he recorded 39 points (6G, 33A) in 72 games to finish tied for first in assists among team defensemen and second in goals and points. The St-Hyacinthe, Quebec, native has totaled 92 points (22G, 70A) in 168 career AHL contests with San Diego and the Toronto Marlies. Prior to turning pro, Brouillard played 57 career contests with McGill University in Canada, registering 49 points (22G, 27A). He was named an Ontario University Athletics All-Star in each of his last two seasons and the best defenseman in Canada in his final season in university (2019-20).
