### AT A GLANCE

#### IF IT WEREN'T FOR THOSE MEDAL-ING KIDS

The Kings were well represented on the podium at the 2026 Olympic Winter Games in Milan Cortina. Forward **Joel Armia** recorded three points (1-2=3) on Feb. 21 to lead Team Finland to a bronze medal, while defenseman **Drew Doughty** and goaltender **Darcy Kuemper** secured silver with Team Canada the following day. Additionally, Kings' Head Equipment Manager **Darren Granger** represented Canada, while Goaltending Coach **Mike Buckley** served on the coaching staff for Team USA, who captured the country's first gold medal since 1980 on Sunday at Milano Santagiulia Ice Hockey Arena. Armia finished the tournament as Team Finland's leading scorer (3-5=8 in 6 GP), which tied **Juraj Slafkovsky** (4-4=8), **Martin Necas** (3-5=8), and **Quinn Hughes** (1-7=8) for the fourth most among all players at this year's tournament. Armia matched the sixth-most points by a Finn in an Olympic tournament involving NHL players (also **Jere Lehtinen** in 2006 & **Olli Jokinen** in 2006), behind **Saku Koivu** (11 in 2006 & 10 in 1998), **Teemu Selanne** (11 in 2006 & 10 in 1998) and **Ville Peltonen** (9 in 2006), per NHL PR.

#### WELCOME TO LA, BREADMAN

Forward **Artemi Panarin** will take the ice for the first time as a member of the LA Kings tomorrow evening at Crypto.com Arena. On Tuesday, Feb. 3, the Kings acquired Panarin from the New York Rangers in exchange for forward **Liam Greentree**, a conditional third round pick in the 2026 NHL Draft and a conditional fourth round pick in the 2028 NHL Draft. The 34-year-old winger skated in 52 games for the Rangers this season, recording 19 goals and 38 assists as part of his 11th consecutive 50-point campaign (19-38=57) with 17 even-strength goals, three game-winning goals, two power-play goals, and 158 shots on goal.
