TOP NOTES

Casey Mittelstadt's game-winning shootout goal was the fifth shootout goal of his career and his third game-deciding shootout goal. He is now 5-for-16 (31.3) in the shootout in his career.

Rasmus Dahlin skated 31:43 in tonight's game, which set a new single-game career high and marked his sixth consecutive game of 29 or more minutes. The stretch is the longest by an NHL skater since Erik Karlsson did so in seven straight games from Feb. 25, 2016 to March 8, 2016.

As a result, **Dahlin** became the second skater in NHL history (Drew Doughty; Nov. 4 to 18, 2014) to skate 29 minutes or more in six or more consecutive games prior to their 24th birthday.

Ukko-Pekka Luukkonen made 30 saves on 32 shots in tonight's game, which marked the ninth time this season he has registered 30 or more saves in a single game.

Luukkonen stopped all four Carolina shootout attempts and became the first Sabres goaltender since Jhonas Enroth on Nov. 29, 2014 at Montreal to make four or more saves and allow no goals in a shootout. Enroth and Ryan Miller (four times) are the only Buffalo goaltenders who have done so.

As a result of his second-period goal, Jeff Skinner has now registered 13 points (7+6) in 13 games against Carolina in his career. As a member of the Hurricanes, **Skinner** appeared in 579 games and recorded 379 points (204+175) in that span.

Dylan Cozens recorded the primary assist on **Skinner's** goal and he has 13 points (4+9) in his last 13 games, including five points in his last five games

Owen Power's goal marked the second time in his career that he has scored to tie a game in the third period. He also did so on April 29, 2022 vs. Chicago. He is now one goal shy of his single-season career high (4), which he set in 79 games in 2022-23.

Zach Benson recorded an assist on Power's goal, which marked the third time this season he has recorded at least one assist in consecutive games. He did so most recently from Dec. 19 to 21 (0+3).
