

TOP NOTES

Alex Tuch's shootout goal marked the sixth game-deciding goal in a shootout of his career. It was his first game-deciding shootout goal since April 6, 2023

As a result of his goal, **Tage Thompson** has now recorded one point in each of his last three games against the Oilers (2+1). The goal was **Thompson's** seventh power-play goal of the season, second-most among all Sabres skaters (Jeff Skinner, eight).

Thompson also recorded Buffalo's first goal in the shootout, improving his career shootout numbers to 8-for-19 (42.1 percent). Among Sabres skaters all-time with at least five shootout attempts, Thompson ranks 10th in shootout shooting percentage. He is now tied with Daniel Briere and Jack Eichel for the seventh-most shootout goals in Sabres history.

Jacob Bryson's goal was his first of 2023-24 and his first goal since he scored on Nov. 4, 2022 at Carolina.

Bryson's goal marked the third time this season a Sabres defenseman has scored to tie a game in the third period. Rasmus Dahlin did so on Nov. 7 at Carolina and Owen Power did so on Feb. 25 vs. Carolina.

Ukko-Pekka Luukkonen made 30 saves on 32 shots and he has now allowed three or fewer goals in 22 of his last 23 appearances. Following today's game, Luukkonen ranked first in goals-against average (1.90) and save percentage (.931) among all NHL goaltenders who had played in at least 10 games since Dec. 30.

Including today's game, **Luukkonen** has posted a save percentage of .930 or better in 17 appearances this season. He has allowed three or fewer goals in 33 of his 40 games played in 2023-24.

Luukkonen has a goals-against average of 2.42 through his first 40 games of 2023-24. It marks the lowest goals-against average posted by a Sabres goaltender with 40 or more games played in a season since Chad Johnson in 2015-16 (2.36). The only other Sabres goaltenders to have a goals-against average below 2.42 are Martin Biron (2001-02, 2.22), Ryan Miller (2009-10; 2.22) and Dominik Hasek (six times).

Tonight's win marked the second time this season, and the first since Jan. 24 at Los Angeles, the Sabres have earned a win after trailing by two or more goals in the first period.
