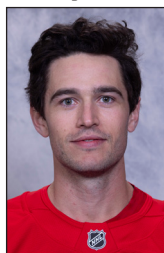

TOP NOTES

Jason Zucker's power-play goal was his first tally as a member of the Sabres. He has recorded six points in his last six games (1+5) including today's contest.

Tage Thompson's primary assist on **Zucker's** goal gave him a six-game point streak (6+4), which marked his first point streak of six or more games since he notched at least one point in seven consecutive games from Feb. 15 to 28, 2023 (6+5).

Thompson's second goal gave him three points (2+1) in today's game. It marked the ninth time in his career that he has recorded multiple goals and at least one assist in a single game in his career.

Thompson is now riding a four-game assist streak, which marks his fourth assist streak of four or more games in his career and his first since March 18 to 24, 2024 (four games).

Rasmus Dahlin recorded an assist on both of Buffalo's first-period goals and added another assist on **Thompson's** second goal. His performance marked the 40th multi-assist performance of his career, the second-most among all defensemen in franchise history (Phil Housley, 77). He has now posted 10 points (3+7) in his last eight home games against the Red Wings.

Dahlin's three assists matched his single-game career high. He last recorded three assists in a game on Jan. 7, 2023 vs. Minnesota.

Thompson has now registered at least one goal in three consecutive games and his two goals today gave him a goal streak of three or more games for the first time since April 2 to 7, 2024 (three games). The goals marked the seventh such streak of his career.

JJ Peterka registered the primary assist on **Thompson's** first goal and he has now posted six points (4+2) in his last five games.

Bowen Byram's goal was his first of the season and his fourth as a member of the Sabres. He last recorded a goal on March 12, 2024 vs. Detroit (2+0).

Owen Power's assist on **Byram's** goal gave him at least one point in four straight games (1+5), which matched the longest point streak of his career (1+3, Oct. 24 to Nov. 1, 2023; 3+1, Jan. 21 to 26, 2023).
