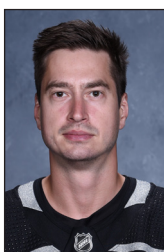

TOP NOTES

Ukko-Pekka Luukkonen made 33 saves and recorded his fourth shutout of the season in tonight's game. His four shutouts are the most in a single season by a Sabres goaltender since Ryan Miller recorded six in 2011-12.

Luukkonen is the first Sabres goaltender since Craig Anderson on Dec. 13, 2022 vs. Los Angeles (40 saves) to record 30 or more saves without allowing a goal.

Tonight's game marked the first time Buffalo had recorded seven or more goals in a shutout since Nov. 8, 2001 vs. Atlanta (8-0).

With his two points (1+1), **JJ Peterka** has now recorded nine points (6+3) in his last eight games, including five goals in his last five games. He has registered six points (4+2) in three career games against the Kings.

Jacob Bryson's assist on **Peterka's** goal marked his first point of 2023-24 and his first point since he recorded an assist on March 6, 2023 vs. Edmonton. He notched two assists in the game, which marked the sixth multi-assist performance of his career and his first since Dec. 7, 2022 at Columbus.

Jordan Greenway recorded three points (2+1) in tonight's game, which marked his third multi-point performance of the season. It marked the third multi-goal performance of his career and his first with Buffalo.

Kyle Okposo's goal gave him one goal in each of his last two games. It marked the fourth time this season he had recorded at least one goal in two or more consecutive games. As a result, he tied his goal total from 2022-23 (11), which he set in 75 games.

Dylan Cozens tallied the primary assist on **Okposo's** goal and he has now totaled 10 points (4+6) in his last 10 games. He leads all Sabres skaters in primary assists (17) in 2023-24. In six games against the Kings in his career, **Cozens** has registered seven points (2+5).

Rasmus Dahlin's recorded two points (1+1) in tonight's game and moved into second place among all NHL defensemen in goals (14) in 2023-24. It marked the sixth time this season that he had registered at least one goal and one assist in a single game.

Casey Mittelstadt recorded a plus/minus of plus-5 in tonight's game, the highest single-game total of his career.
