#### THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW

The Sabres have earned at least one point in three of their last four games against the Hurricanes (2-1-1).

Buffalo has earned at least one point in six of the team's last seven home games against Carolina (3-1-3).



JJ Peterka has posted 14 points (2+12) in his last 13 games, including six assists in his last five games.

Jack Quinn has tallied 12 points (7+5) in his last 12 games, including at least one goal in back-to-back games.

A goal in tonight's game would give Quinn the longest goal streak of his career.

In his last 10 games, Jason Zucker has recorded 10 points (7+3).

**Tage Thompson** has posted nine points (3+6) in his last nine games.

Peyton Krebs has recorded one assist in consecutive games and an assist tonight would give him the longest assist streak of his career.

Ryan McLeod has registered one point in back-to-back games against the Hurricanes (1+1).



### THE RAS AND THE FURIOUS

Rasmus Dahlin has recorded 12 assists in his last nine games.

Dahlin's current five-game assist streak is his longest such streak of the season and he would match the longest assist

streak of his career (Oct. 14 to 24, 2023; six games) with an assist in tonight's game.

Dahlin has recorded four points (2+2) in his last four games against Carolina.

Among Sabres defensemen all-time, **Dahlin** ranks third in points (323) and he trails only Mike Ramsey (329) and Phil Housley (558) on Buffalo's all-time



Dahlin has recorded 72 goals in his career, one shy of tying Ramsey (73) for the second-most all-time among all Buffalo defensemen.

#### **ON THIS DATE**

The Sabres are 10-11-3 all-time on January 15.

January 15, 1972: Jim Lorentz makes his debut with the Sabres after a midseason trade from the NY Rangers.

January 15, 1992: The Sabres tie the New Jersey Devils 8-8 in New Jersey in what was the highest-scoring tie in franchise history and tied for the highestscoring tie in NHL history. Dale Hawerchuk ties a franchise record with five assists in the game.



#### **ALL I DO IS QUINN**

Since Dec. 15, Jack Quinn has registered 12 points (7+5) in 12 games played.

In that span and among all Sabres skaters, Quinn is tied with Jason Zucker for the team lead in goals and he is tied with Rasmus Dahlin for second in points.

He ranks tied for tenth among all NHL skaters in goals in that span.

Quinn has scored on 33.3 percent of his shots since Dec. 15, the highest mark of any Sabres skater and tied for the most among all NHL skaters in that span (min. 20 shots).
