

## AT A GLANCE

### CAN'T CATCH 22

Forward **Kevin Fiala** started the 2026 calendar year with his third multi-point outing (1-1=2) of the season on Thursday night versus Tampa Bay. The winger collected his 13th helper of the season before breaking a tie with **Adrian Kempe** (13 G) by scoring his team-leading 14th goal of the season. He now prepares for the first of two consecutive games against his former team, the Minnesota Wild. On Oct. 13, Fiala extended his point streak against the Wild to a seventh game (3-6=9), dating back to Oct. 19, 2023, and has an opportunity to break a three-way tie with teammate **Anze Kopitar** (2-9=11 in 7 GP from Feb. 24, 2011 – April 4, 2013) and **Jack Johnson** (2-6=8 in 7 GP from Feb. 24, 2009 – Oct. 25, 2010) for the longest point streak against the Wild in Kings history.

### JUICY JANUARY

On Oct. 13 in Minnesota, **Adrian Kempe** tied the game 3-3 with 46 seconds remaining in regulation. With his last-minute game-tying goal on Nov. 20 in San Jose, Kempe became the third player in Kings history to score a game-tying goal in the final minute of regulation multiple times in a single season, joining **Anze Kopitar** (2x: 2017-18 and 2008-09) and **Ziggy Palffy** (2003-04). Kempe can become the first to do so three times in a single campaign. With his late-game heroics in the Gopher State, Kempe enters tomorrow's contest carrying a three-game goal streak against the Wild and has five total points (3-2=5) over that span, dating back to Dec. 7, 2024. Should he score this evening, he will join **Jeff Carter** (4 G from March 30 – Oct. 3, 2013) as the only two Kings players to record a four-game goal streak against Minnesota.
