ANAHEIM DUCKS COACHING STAFF



DALLAS EAKINS

HEAD COACH

Dallas Eakins completed his first season as head coach of the Anaheim Ducks in 2019-20, his fifth season within the organization. Eakins previously served as head coach for Anaheim's American Hockey League affiliate in San Diego from 2015-19. In his four seasons behind the bench, Eakins led the Gulls to a 154-95-23 record and three trips to the Calder Cup Playoffs. In addition, San Diego led the AHL Pacific Division in wins, points (331) and points percentage (.608) since the division's inception in 2015-16.

Eakins joined the Anaheim organization June 26, 2015 after serving as head coach of the Edmonton Oilers from 2013-15. Eakins previously spent four seasons as head coach of the AHL's Toronto Marlies (2009-13). In 584 career AHL games with San Diego and Toronto, Eakins led his teams to a 311-209-64 record and

five appearances in the Calder Cup Playoffs. Eakins helped San Diego advance to the 2019 Western Conference Finals and guided his 2011-12 Marlies club to an appearance in the 2012 Calder Cup Finals.

The Dade City, FL native guided the Marlies to the top of the North Division standings during his final two seasons behind the bench in Toronto while winning four of six playoff series. As a member of the Marlies, Eakins was named one of two head coaches to represent the Western Conference for the AHL All-Star Games for both the 2011-12 and 2012-13 seasons.

Selected by Washington in the 10th round (208th overall) of the 1985 NHL Draft, Eakins appeared in 120 career NHL games with the Winnipeg Jets, Florida Panthers, St. Louis Blues, Phoenix Coyotes, New York Rangers, Toronto Maple Leafs, New York Islanders and Calgary Flames. Eakins also played in the AHL and International Hockey League during his professional career, winning both the Calder Cup (2002) and Turner Cup (2000). His final professional season was with the Manitoba Moose (AHL) before retiring as a player May 26, 2004.

Eakins, his wife, Ingrid, and daughters, Emerson and Cameron reside in Coto de Caza.

DARRYL SUTTER ADVISOR TO THE COACHING STAFF

Darryl Sutter finished his first season with the Anaheim Ducks as advisor to the coaching staff in 2019-20. Sutter guided the Los Angeles Kings to a pair of Stanley Cup championships in 2012 and 2014, finishing with franchise-best 225 career wins (225-147-53). Sutter was previously the general manager of the Calgary Flames from 2003-10, and head coach from 2002-06. The Viking, Alberta native compiled a 107-73-30 regular-season record and an 18-15 mark in the postseason with the Flames. In 2003-04, he led Calgary to the Stanley Cup Final and a first-place finish (46-25-11, 103 points) in the Northwest Division.

Prior to his time in Calgary, Sutter served as the head coach of the San Jose Sharks for six seasons from 1997-03. Sutter began his coaching career with the Chicago Blackhawks, beginning as an assistant coach (1987-88), associate coach (1990-92), and then head coach (1992-93). In his first season as an NHL head coach, Sutter led Chicago to the best record in the Campbell Conference (47-25-12).

Sutter played 406 career NHL games with Chicago, recording 161-118=279 points and 288 penalty minutes. He scored 20-plus goals in five of his eight NHL seasons, including a career-high 40 goals in 1980-81. Sutter, who served as Chicago's team captain from 1982-85 and again from 1986-87, also had 24-19=43 points in 51 career playoff games.



MARK MORRISON ASSISTANT COACH

Mark Morrison completed his third season as an assistant coach for Anaheim. Morrison joined the organization prior to 2017-18, a season in which the Ducks posted a 44-25-13 record for 101 points.

A native of Prince George, British Columbia, Morrison was previously with the Winnipeg Jets organization as an assistant coach for the AHL Manitoba Moose (2015-17) and St. John's IceCaps (2011-15).

Prior to St. John's, Morrison served as head coach and general manager of the Victoria Salmon Kings of the ECHL, where he spent four years. He also coached and played with the Fife Flyers of the British National League, winning Coach of the Year honors three times.

Morrison played 10 NHL games with the New York Rangers from 1981-84, won the Adams Cup with the CHL's Tulsa Oilers and was named Most Sportsmanlike Player in the 1980-81 Memorial Cup. He also represented Canada at the World Junior Championships in 1982 (gold medal) and 1983.

Morrison has three children: son, Lance, and daughters, Nicole and Tara.



MARTY WILFORD ASSISTANT COACH

Marty Wilford concluded his second season as an assistant coach with the Ducks and his ninth season overall in the Anaheim organization. Wilford spent the previous seven seasons as an assistant coach with Anaheim's AHL affiliate in San Diego (2015-18), Norfolk (2012-15) and Syracuse (2011-12).

Wilford helped the Gulls to a 118-71-10-5 record in his three seasons in San Diego, including an appearance in the Pacific Division Finals in 2016 and 2017. From 2012-15, Wilford was part of a Norfolk coaching staff that led the Admirals to a 104-99-25 record and a win over top-seeded Manchester in the opening round of the 2014 Calder Cup Playoffs. Wilford made his professional coaching debut in 2011-12 at Syracuse, which went 37-29-10 and earned a berth in the 2012 Calder Cup Playoffs.

Originally selected by Chicago in the sixth round (149th overall) of the 1995 NHL Draft, Wilford collected 47-228=275 points with 573 PIM as a defenseman in 539 career AHL games from 2000-07. He ranked as Norfolk's all-time leading scorer among defensemen with 32-141=173 points in 318 games from 2000-05.

Wilford began his professional career in the International Hockey League, scoring 3-29=32 points in 186 games between 1997-00. He spent his final four seasons in Europe with Hamburg and Iserlong (Germany), and Fassa HC (Italy), notching 19-121=140 points in 146 contests. Wilford and his wife, Shelly, have three children: Emma, Grayce and Nash.

SUDARSHAN MAHARAJ GOALTENDING COACH

Sudarshan “Sudsie” Maharaj (Sud-DARE-shun MAH-ha-raj) finished his fourth season as goaltending coach for the Anaheim Ducks. In 2017-18, the Ducks established a franchise-record with a .923 SV%, which co-led all NHL teams. In addition, both Ryan Miller (.928) and John Gibson (.926) surpassed the individual single-season franchise record for SV% (.924, Jonas Hiller in 2010-11, Gibson in 2016-17).

Maharaj joined the Ducks organization prior to the 2013-14 season in a consultant role focused on the club’s AHL affiliate in Norfolk, VA. Maharaj continued in the role throughout the team’s transition to San Diego for the 2015-16 season, where he helped Gulls goaltenders to a 39-23-8 record, 2.87 GAA, .906 SV% and a berth in the Calder Cup Playoffs.

A native of Trinidad, Maharaj spent eight seasons with the New York Islanders from 2003-06 (goaltending coach) and 2009-12 (goaltending consultant). He also helped develop the National Goaltending Development Program for Hockey Canada (2005-07) and served as goaltending consultant for the Korean national hockey team in preparation for the 2018 Olympic Winter Games.

Raised in Toronto from the age of six, Maharaj was a member of the 1984-85 National Hockey Championship York University team and played six seasons of pro hockey in Sweden.

Sudarshan and his wife, Yvonne, have two daughters, Alexandra and Katherine.



LARRY BARRON SKATING SKILLS & DEVELOPMENT COACH

Larry Barron concluded his second season as skating skills and development coach for the Anaheim Ducks. Prior to assuming his current role, Barron served as a skating consultant for the Ducks from 2013-18.

A native of Toronto, Ontario, Barron coached at the Under-16 and Under-18 levels from 2012-16, including Jr. Ducks 18AAA teams, and made two national championship appearances as head coach during that time.

With a 26-year background in youth hockey, Barron also owns Barron Hockey Academy in Lake Forest, CA, which offers on-ice development and team training for local players ranging from amateur to professional backgrounds.

Barron resides in Ladera Ranch with his wife, Michelle, and their three children: Dillon, Peyton and Brock.



JOE PISCOTTY VIDEO COACH

Joe Piscotty finished his ninth season as video coach, his 10th overall season with the organization. Piscotty originally joined the Ducks prior to the 2010-11 season as a video scouting analyst, assisting Hockey Operations with special projects before moving to his current role on Dec. 2, 2011.

Piscotty worked with the University of Michigan’s hockey team from 2006-08, serving as a graduate student manager under Head Coach Red Berenson. He was with the Wolverines when the club advanced to the Frozen Four in 2008. While at Michigan, Piscotty also earned a Master’s in Sports Management.

In addition, Piscotty served as a hockey operations assistant for the University of Denver’s men’s squad from 2008-10. He completed his time at Denver with a Master’s degree in Business Administration (MBA). A native of Huntington Beach, Piscotty earned his Bachelor’s degree in Business Administration from the University of Las Vegas, Nevada in 2006.

Joe and his wife, Carrie, reside in Huntington Beach with daughters, Kadence and Lea.



BRETT FERGUSON VIDEO COACH

Brett Ferguson completed his 10th season with the Anaheim organization, his first as a video coach with the Ducks. Ferguson spent the previous nine seasons with Anaheim’s primary development affiliate in the American Hockey League, most recently with San Diego. He served four seasons with the Gulls from 2015-19, the first two years as video coach and the latter two as an assistant coach. Ferguson helped lead the Gulls to Calder Cup Playoff appearances in 2016, 2017 and 2019, advancing to the Pacific Division Final in all three years and the Western Conference Finals in 2019.

Born in Sioux City, Iowa and raised in West Des Moines, Ferguson spent five seasons as video coach with Anaheim’s AHL affiliates in Norfolk (2012-15) and Syracuse (2010-12). Ferguson, who began his professional coaching career as an assistant coach with Des Moines (USHL) in 2009-10, graduated from the University of South Carolina at Aiken in 2009 with a Bachelor’s degree in history.

Ferguson, his wife, Amanda, and their sons, Caleb and Aiden, reside in Irvine.

2019-20 SEASON IN REVIEW

THE 2019-20 SEASON: The Ducks concluded the 2019-20 season with a 29-33-9 record and 67 points...Anaheim had played 71 games until the regular season was paused Mar. 12 and eventually deemed completed May 26 due to the COVID-19 pandemic...going into Mar. 12, the Ducks had won three of their last five games and earned points in four of those contests (3-1-1, 7 pts)...over its final 10 games, Anaheim posted a 5-3-2 record for 12 points, which ranked tied for fourth among NHL teams over that time frame...during the month of March, the club was fourth among NHL teams in goals (19), while also leading the league in hits (175) and blocked shots (113)...the Ducks also went 9-7-4 in 20 games since Feb. 1...newcomers **Danton Heinen, Sonny Milano, Andrew Agozzino, Matt Irwin, David Backes and Christian Djoos** combined for 7-7=14 points in the eight games with Anaheim following the trade deadline.

TEAM LEADERS: **Adam Henrique** led the club in points (26-17=43) and goals for the first time since joining the Ducks...Henrique's 26 goals marked his fifth 20-goal season and fell just four shy of his career high...**Ryan Getzlaf** paced the Ducks with 29 assists in a season he became the club's all-time leader in games played, the first player to appear in 1,000 games with Ducks and the NHL's all-time leader in overtime assists (24).

FINAL GAME POSTPONED GAME: Anaheim's final game of the shortened season also represented the continuation of the postponed contest between the Blues and Ducks, originally set for Feb. 11 but rescheduled by the NHL due to a medical emergency that occurred at 12:10 of the first period involving defenseman Jay Bouwmeester...the contest followed the same 60-minute format of regular-season games and began with the score tied, 1-1, as it was at the time of the postponement...**Adam Henrique** (Anaheim) and Ivan Barbashev (St. Louis) provided the original goals, which carried over to the Mar. 11 rescheduled date...**Jani Hakanpaa** also scored for Anaheim, marking his first career NHL goal...the game was the second contest of a home back-to-back, which began with a 5-2 win Mar. 10 vs. OTT...the last time Anaheim had played home games on consecutive days was Apr 7-8, 2013, defeating LAK (W, 4-3 in shootout) and EDM (W, 2-1).

FRANCHISE BEST: **Ryan Getzlaf** became the franchise's all-time leader in games played Oct. 11 @ CBJ, surpassing Corey Perry (988) with his 989th career appearance...Getzlaf also became the first player in club history to play 1,000 games with Anaheim on Nov. 3 vs. CHI (see note below)...of his 1,053 career games, Getzlaf has served 700 of those as Anaheim's captain, the most in franchise history...he also passed Henrik Sedin (23) for the NHL's all-time lead in overtime assists following a 4-3 victory Feb. 25 vs. EDM...Getzlaf finished the season leading the Ducks in GWG (5) and assists (29), while ranking tied for second in points (13-29=42).

CAPTAIN 1,000: Ducks captain **Ryan Getzlaf** became the first Duck in franchise history to reach 1,000 games Nov. 3 vs. CHI...Getzlaf became the sixth NHL player in the last 40 NHL seasons to play their first 1,000 games with one franchise and win 548 (or more) of them (now at 568-362-127)...Getzlaf also became the eighth active player to appear in his first 1,000 career games with the same team, and the 53rd all-time (19th as a center)...with his appearance Nov. 3, Getzlaf was the 20th active skater and the 336th player in NHL history to reach the milestone...he also was the 12th player all-time to appear in his 1,000th game while a member of the Ducks.

TEAM 1,000: The Ducks played their 1,000th all-time regular-season game in Anaheim Nov. 14 vs. San Jose at Honda Center...after the NHL awarded Anaheim and the Walt Disney Company a franchise on Dec. 10, 1992, the Ducks hosted their first ever game in Anaheim on Oct. 8, 1993 vs. Detroit...over the last 26 years and through over 1,000 games at Honda Center, the Ducks have posted a 547-341-136 all-time record (excluding "home" neutral site games)...Anaheim's first win in club history came in Anaheim on Oct. 13, 1993 vs. Edmonton (4-3)...the Ducks posted their 500th all-time win at Honda Center with a 4-3 shootout decision over the Winnipeg Jets on Jan. 25, 2018, reaching the milestone victory in their 932nd all-time game in Anaheim.

TEAM 2,000: The Ducks played their 2,000th game in franchise history Nov. 3 vs. Chicago, a 3-2 overtime loss...Anaheim concluded the 2019-20 regular season with a 973-804-278 record since its inaugural NHL season in 1993-94...since their debut season, the Ducks rank tied for eighth in goals against per game (2.72).

LEADERBOARD CHECK: **Cam Fowler** surpassed Scott Niedermayer for the franchise's all-time lead among defensemen in several categories during 2019-20...Fowler scored his 61st career goal Oct. 29 vs. WPG to become the club's all-time leader in goals by a defenseman...he started the season Oct. 3 vs. ARI by assuming the all-time franchise lead in GWG by a defenseman with his 14th game winner in a 2-1 victory...Fowler quickly followed up by becoming the first Anaheim defenseman to reach 1,000 career shots, Oct. 11 @ CBJ...he also earned his 300th career NHL point Feb. 7 @ TOR to become the first Ducks blueliner to reach the milestone.

FAST & NATURAL 3: **Nicolas Deslauriers** recorded a hat trick in the first 11:49 of a 5-2 win Mar. 10 vs. OTT, marking the fastest three goals from the start of an NHL game since Taylor Hall (EDM) scored three goals in 7:53 Mar. 30, 2013 vs. VAN...it was also the fifth-fastest NHL hat trick from the start of a game since 1990 and the fastest in Ducks history, besting the previous record held by Teemu Selanne (12:58 on Nov. 10, 1997 vs. SJS)...the last NHL player to have his first career hat trick in the opening 11:49 of a game was CHI's Dustin Byfuglien (Nov. 30, 2007 vs. PHX)...it was also the third hat trick in club history scored in the first period and the ninth natural hat trick for a Ducks player...in total, Anaheim scored four first-period goals, tying a season high for goals in a period (also Oct. 29 vs. WPG, second period).

IN NET: **John Gibson** wrapped up the season tied for the 10th-highest career SV% (.918) among all-time NHL goaltenders with at least 200 games played...Gibson also finished 2019-20 tied for fifth among active goaltenders...Gibson stopped all 26 shots he faced en route to a 3-0 win over the Islanders Nov. 25 and his 19th career shutout, the fourth-most in franchise history.

MILLER'S MOVES: **Ryan Miller** earned his 386th career NHL win and surpassed Mike Vernon (385) for sole possession of 15th place on the NHL's all-time wins list in a 4-3 overtime win Mar. 4 @ COL...Miller, who made seven saves in overtime and 32 in total that night, also passed Tom Barrasso (755) for second for all-time games started for U.S.-born goalies...in his following appearance on Mar. 6 vs. Toronto, Miller moved past Barrasso (777) for sole possession of second place on the NHL's all-time games played list for U.S.-born goaltenders...on Feb. 17 in Calgary, Miller made 37 saves to surpass Gilles Meloche (21,138) for sole possession of 13th place on the NHL's all-time saves list...below is a look at several all-time rankings Miller is amongst.
