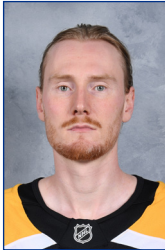

TOP NOTES

Tage Thompson's first goal gave him a four-game goal streak, tied for the longest such streak of his career (twice). He has recorded eight points (7+1) in his last five games against the Bruins.

Thompson has posted 45 points (27+18) in his last 41 games, including 10 points (9+1) in his last eight games. His second goal of the game marked his seventh multi-goal game of the season, the most among all Sabres skaters and tied for the fourth-most among all NHL skaters.

Thompson's third goal gave him eight hat tricks in his career, tied with Thomas Vanek for the sixth-most in Sabres history.

As a result of his assist, **JJ Peterka** has tallied nine points (5+4) in his last eight games against Boston, including at least one point in three straight games against the Bruins (4+2).

Peterka (4+3) became the first Sabres skater since Vanek from April 7, 2012 to Feb. 10, 2013 (three games; 3+4) to record six or more points in any three-game span against Boston.

With his two point (1+1) performance, **Alex Tuch** has posted 12 points (7+5) in his last eight games, including at least one point in six straight games. His goal gave him six point streaks of six or more games in his career and his second such streak of the season (Nov. 11 to 23, 2024; 3+6).

Rasmus Dahlin's goal gave him two points (1+1) in tonight's game and he is tied for first place among all Sabres skaters in multi-point games this season (16).

Dahlin has posted 10 points (3+7) in his last eight games, including at least one point in three straight games (2+3).

Jason Zucker tallied a goal and is now riding a four-game point streak (2+3), including he has scored one goal in back-to-back games. It marked his fifth point streak of four or more games this season. **Zucker's** four game-winning goals this season are tied with **Tuch** for the second-most among all Sabres skaters (**Thompson**, five).

Peyton Krebs recorded two assists in tonight's game and he has registered eight points (3+5) in his last seven games.
