

A fifth round draft choice of the Rangers in 2022, Maxim Barbashev tallied 15 goals and 27 assists for 42 points in 59 games for the Moncton Wildcats of the QMJHL in 2021-22. Barbashev ranked tied for third on Moncton in points, fourth in goals and tied for second in assists. In two seasons with Moncton, the 6-1, 183 pound forward has notched 21 goals and 31 assists for 52 points in 69 games.
