**OLEN ZELLWEGER** leads AHL rookie blueliners in PPG (3) and shots (97), ranks tied for second in points (6-16=22), second in assists and third in goals. He also lead San Diego skaters in shots, ranks second in PPG, ranks third in points and assists, while ranking tied for fourth in goals.

**TREVOR CARRICK** ranks tied for seventh among league defensemen in points (5-19=24). Carrick leads the Gulls in assists and ranks second in points.

**GLENN GAWDIN** co-leads San Diego in goals (10) and ranks fourth among team skaters in points (10-10=20). Gawdin is currently riding a threegame point streak (2-1=3).

CHASE DE LEO leads the Gulls in points per game (0.93) and has 6-8=14 through 15 games on the season.

**TOMAS SUCHANEK** earned his second straight win, stopping 32-of-34 shots Jan. 12 vs. Iowa, improving to 6-2-1 with a 2.09 GAA and .933 SV % with one shutout on the season.

CALLE CLANG has helped San Diego earn standing points in all of his last four starts, going 2-0-2.

**YEGOR SIDOROV** ranks second in the WHL in goals (35) and GWG (8), third in PPG (11) and 13th in points (35-21=56). He leads Saskatoon in goals, PPG and GWG while ranking second on the team in scoring and fourth in assists. Sidorov is currently averaging 1.40 points per game and is riding a four game point streak (1-3=4).

**CAREY TERRANCE** ranks tied for second among OHL leaders in SHG (4) and tied for 10th in goal scoring (23). He also leads the Erie Otters in goals and SHG, while ranking third in points (23-13=36). Terrance has 5-1=6 points through his last seven games.

**RODWIN DIONICIO** ranks tied for fourth among OHL defensemen in goals (12) and tied for 14th in points (12-19=31). He also ranks tied for second among Saginaw blueliners in points and second in goals.
