### AT A GLANCE

#### WELCOME TO LA, BREADMAN

Forward **Artemi Panarin** recorded a pair of assists (0-2=2) in his debut appearance in black-and-silver last night against the Vegas Golden Knights. The native of Korkino, Russia, became the third Kings player in the past 20 years to record multiple assists in their team debut, following **Vladimir Tkachev** (0-2=2 on Oct. 14, 2021) and **Ryan Smyth** (0-2=2 on Oct. 3, 2009), per NHL PR. The pair of assists were recorded in Panarin's 400th career home game and mark the 299th and 300th home assists of his career. Panarin is the 10th Russian skater in NHL history to record 300 career home helpers, the first undrafted skater from his native country to do so.

#### NINE IS NAILS

Forward **Adrian Kempe** returned to Los Angeles for the first contest of the Kings' six-game homestand last night against the Vegas Golden Knights after spending the previous two weeks representing his native Sweden at the 2026 Olympic Winter Games in Milan Cortina. The native of Kramfors, Sweden, scored two goals and four points (2-2=4) in five games played for the Tre Kronor at the tournament. Prior to departing for Italy, Kempe posted an eight-game point streak (5-5=10) from Jan. 17 through Feb. 4, his second career point streak of such length. Kempe (1-1=2) marked his return to NHL action by scoring his 21st goal, recording his 27th assist, and 10th multi-point effort of the season – the most among Kings skaters in all three categories. The 29-year-old has points in each of his last four regular-season home games (1-4=5) against the Oilers, and five points (1-4=5) in his last three regular-season games versus Edmonton overall.
