MATCHUP NOTES

- The Blue Jackets have won five of their last seven overall matchups against Toronto since Dec. 14, 2023 (5-2-0).
- Columbus has scored five-plus goals in all five victories over the stretch, including six or more in four of them.
- The Blue Jackets have gone 12-6-0 in their last 18 trips to Scotiabank Arena since Feb. 19, 2009.
- Seven of the last 11 games, inclduing five-straight, in the series have seen the winning team score five goals or more.
- The Jackets have killed off all nine Leafs power play chances in the last four contests.
- The winning team has won by three or more goals in four-straight meetings and five of the last six.
- The teams have combined for six or more goals in 11 of the last 14 games of the series, including nine instances with seven-plus goals.
- RW Kent Johnson has notched 3-4-7 with assists in four of his five career games played at Toronto.
- D Zach Werenski has collected points in eight of his last 10 games vs. Toronto (1-11-12) after posting 1-1-2 in Oct. 29 meeting and has 0-5-5 in his last five games played at Scotiabank Arena.



JACKET TO WATCH - RW Mathieu Olivier

Has 3-5-8 in six career GP against Toronto. Notched his first career 4-point effort last time out on Oct. 29 (1-3-4) and has picked up all career points in his last 5 games with 0-3-3 in his last 3 at Toronto.



LEAF TO WATCH - C John Tavares

Has 20-23-43 with 12 multi-point efforts in 39 career GP against Columbus. Has points in five of his last six games overall vs. the club (3-3-6). Has totaled 10-12-22 in 17 career home outings.



TEAM NOTES

- The Blue Jackets recorded points in five-straight games (3-0-2) and competed in six consecutive one-goal contests prior to a 5-2 loss at Winnipeg on Tuesday.
- The club began a four-game road trip on Tuesday (also Nov. 22 at Detroit, Nov. 24 at Washington) and is in a stretch of nineof-12 games played on the road from Nov. 2-24. CBJ play 18 of their first 30 games of the campaign away on the road.
- All five of the Blue Jackets' top faceoff takers (min. 75 faceoffs) have won more than 50 pct. of their draws taken (Jenner, 56.0; Monahan, 54.1; Lundestrom, 53.5; Fantilli, 52.1; Coyle, 51.6).
- CBJ have converted on 3-of-10 power play chances over their last five outings since Nov. 11.
- The team is in a stretch of 13-of-14 games played against the Eastern Conference from Nov. 15-Dec. 11.

PLAYER NOTES

- C Charlie Coyle, who has assists in three of the last four contests (1-4-5), sits one point from 500 for his NHL career (192-
- C Adam Fantilli has notched goals in four of the past six games and has points in six of the last eight (4-3-7).
- RW Kirill Marchenko had his career-high assists streak (2-7-9, 6 GP) and points streak (3-12-15, 12 GP) snapped on Tuesday. It was tied with RW Cam Atkinson (12 GP in 2018-19) for the second-longest points streak in club history and the longest in the NHL this season.
- D Zach Werenski, who has points in four-straight outings (2-3-5) and in five of the past six (2-4-6), became the first defenseman in club history to post 400 career points (119-281-400, 587 GP) on Tuesday with a goal. He joins Rick Nash (547) and Cam Atkinson (402) as the only three skaters to reach the milestone in club history, while also becoming the eighth-fastest American-born blueliner to tally 400 points.
