MATCHUP NOTES

- ★ Columbus has earned points in six of the last eight games of the series since Apr. 24, 2022 (5-2-1).
- ★ The home team has recorded points in 10-straight meetings dating back to Mar. 7, 2020 (9-0-1), while CBJ have won four consecutive meetings at Nationwide Arena since Apr. 24, 2022.
- ★ The winning team has won by a margin of three goals or more in 11 of the last 15 meetings and by multiple goals in 16 of the last 19 meetings since Feb. 2, 2016.
- ★ The winning team has scored four or more goals in 14 of the last 15 games of the series, including six-straight.
- ★ The teams have combined for seven-plus goals in six of the past nine games of the series.
- ★ The Blue Jackets have scored a power play goal in four of the last five home contests in the series (4-of-16, 25.0 pct.) and are 14-of-54 on the man advantage over the last 15 home games (25.9 pct.).



JACKET TO WATCH - C Adam Fantilli

Has tallied 2-3-5 with 2 multi-point efforts in 4 career GP against the Oilers. Has recorded points in 3-straight meetings, including 1-1-2 at Edmonton on Monday. Posted 1-1-2 in lone home contest.



OILER TO WATCH - C Connor McDavid

Has tallied 11-25-36 with 11 multi-point efforts in 19 career GP against CBJ. Has recorded 5-7-12 in the past 6 meetings after tallying two goals on Monday.



TEAM NOTES

- ★ The Blue Jackets earned three out of four points in a back-to-back set at Edmonton (5-4 OTL on Monday) and Seattle (2-1 SOW on Tuesday).
- ★ Seven of the Jackets' last nine games, including four of the five on the road trip, have been decided by a single goal (4-2-1 in those contests).
- ★ CBJ, who open a three-game homestand on Thursday, have won three of the past four games at Nationwide Arena.
- ★ Columbus has killed off 15-of-16 opponent power plays over the last eight contests and leads the NHL in penalty kill percentage (93.8 pct.) since Oct. 26.

PLAYER NOTES

- ★ **C Adam Fantilli** posted CBJ's lone goal in regulation on Tuesday to stretch his points streak to three-straight (2-3-5).
- ★ **RW Kirill Marchenko** stretched his career-high points streak to nine-straight games (3-8-11) with an assist on Tuesday. It's tied for the sixth-longest points streak in club history (8th time) and the longest since Patrik Laine's 11-game streak from Jan. 27-Feb. 24, 2022.
- ★ **C Sean Monahan** collected a point for the second consecutive outings (1-1-2) with an assist on Tuesday and has picked up points in eight of the last 11 games since Oct. 21 (2-6-8).
- ★ **D Zach Werenski**, who played in a season-high 31:13 TOI on Tuesday, ranks second in the NHL in TOI/GP (26:47) as well as first among league blueliners in shots on goal (57) and third-T in goals (4).
