AT A GLANCE

HOME SWEET HOME

Following their first of two five-game road-trips in the month of January, the LA Kings return to Crypto.com Arena riding a nine-game winning streak on home ice. The club opened the 2025 calendar year with back-to-back victories against Eastern Conference foes, including a 3-0 shutout victory against New Jersey on New Year's Day and 2-1 win over Tampa on Jan. 4. The current streak is the third time in franchise history that the club has posted a home win streak of at least nine games with their two longest stretches being 12 games (1992-93) and 10 games (1990-91). The Kings skate into DTLA with a home record of 14-2-1 with 29 points and a .853 points percentage (PTS %), the highest in the League:

IT'S A BEAUT, CLARKE

Defenseman **Brandt Clarke** recorded his 20th assist of the season against the Canucks during Thursday night's victory in Vancouver. In doing so, Clarke became the fourth blueliner selected in the 2021 NHL Draft to record a 20-assist season, joining **Luke Hughes** (1x), **Owen Power** (2x) and **JJ Moser** (2x). The offensive leader on the blueline this season, the 21-year-old has added three goals for 23 points (3-20=23) and a plus-11 rating while skating in all 43 games for the Kings this season.
