MATCHUP NOTES

- ★ Columbus has gone 23-20-4 against Colorado after winning just one of the first 22 all-time meetings (1-10-2 from Oct. 2000 to Jan. 2004).
- ★ CBJ have recorded points in 10 of the last 15 home games of the all-time series (7-5-3).
- ★ The winning team has recorded four or more goals in eight-straight meetings and 12 of the past 13 overall as well as six of the last seven at Nationwide Arena since Mar. 8, 2018.
- ★ Each of the last seven outings have been determined by multiple goals with five decided by three or more.
- ★ The Blue Jackets have recorded three shutouts (MR: Steve Mason, 33 saves in 2-0 win at COL on Mar. 1, 2012), a hat trick (Cam Atkinson, 5-2 W at COL on Apr. 5, 2012) and penalty shot (Rick Nash goal, 6-1 W at COL on Jan. 2, 2009) in the all-time series.

JACKET TO WATCH - C Charlie Coyle

Has 12-15-27 with six multi-point efforts in 40 career GP against Colorado. Notched points in eight-straight contests (3-7-10) before spending end of 2024-25 with the club.





AV TO WATCH - C Nathan MacKinnon

Has 7-19-26 with seven multi-point outings in 21 career GP vs. the Blue Jackets. Has points in all but six of the contests and has totaled 3-11-14 in his last six appearances.



TEAM NOTES

- ★ Columbus continues a three-game homestand after falling 3-2 to New Jersey in its first game at Nationwide Arena on Monday. The team finishes the stretch on Saturday against Tampa Bay.
- ★ CBJ are in a stretch of six consecutive games from Oct. 11-24 against teams that made the 2025 Stanley Cup Playoffs.
- ★ The Blue Jackets have outscored their first three opponents 7-1 (+6) during 5-on-5 play this season. The club leads the NHL in fewest goals against at 5-on-5 and goal differential (tied, Carolina).
- ★ Columbus has won 113-of-200 faceoffs taken with the 56.5 percent the fourth-best in the NHL in 2025-26.

PLAYER NOTES

- ★ Goaltenders Jet Greaves (55-of-59, .932 SV%) and Elvis Merzlikins (48-of-52, .923 SV%) have combined to stop 103-of-111 shots faced through the first three games (.928 SV%).
- * RW Kirill Marchenko ranks second-T in the NHL in goals with four through his first three contests and is the second Blue Jacket to record four goals through the first three contests of a season (Sonny Milano, 4-0-4 in 2017-18).
- ★ LW **Dmitri Voronkov** has recorded points in all three games in 2025-26 (2-2-4) and is one contest shy for tying for seventh-longest point streak to begin a campaign in franchise history (5x, MR: Johnson & Severson in 2024-25).
- ★ D Zach Werenski ranks third-T in the NHL in shots on goal (19), while RW Kirill Marchenko ranks 10th-T (17).

ATKINSON RETIRES A BLUE JACKET

- * RW Cam Atkinson will sign a one-day contract that will allow him to officially retire a Blue Jacket on Thursday with a press conference at 11:30am ET at Nationwide Arena. The club will honor Atkinson prior to the game against the Avalanche.
- * Atkinson owns the franchise record for hat tricks (6) and ranks second all-time in goals (213), points (402), game-winning goals (42) and shots on goal (1,883).
