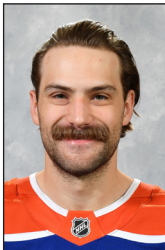

TOP NOTES

As a result of his two-goal performance, **Tage Thompson** has now posted 31 points (17+14) in his last 28 games, including 16 points (11+5) in his last 13. He has now registered at least one point in three straight home games against the Oilers (3+1).

Thompson's first goal marked his first unassisted tally of the season and the 13th of his career. Prior to tonight's game, he last recorded an unassisted goal on March 29, 2024 vs. New Jersey. The goal came in the first period and moved him into first place among all NHL skaters in first-period goals (16) this season.

Alex Tuch registered Buffalo's second goal. **Tuch** has now collected 14 points (9+5) in his last 13 games, including nine goals in his last 11 games. **Tuch** has recorded one point in three consecutive games against Edmonton (2+1).

Ryan McLeod notched the primary assist on **Tuch's** goal, which gave him three assists in his last three games. His 14 goals, 20 assists and 34 points this season are all new single-season career highs.

Thompson's second goal of the game marked his fifth multi-goal game of the season, the most among all Sabres skaters.

Josh Norris registered the primary assist on **Thompson's** second goal, which marked his first point as a member of the Sabres.

Ukko-Pekka Luukkonen made 32 saves in tonight's game, including 12 saves in the third period, which marked the 10th time he has notched 30 or more saves in a single game this season. Buffalo has a 7-2-1 record in those games.

The Sabres have now earned a win in four of their last five home games against the Oilers (4-1-0).

Tonight's win marked Buffalo's 10th win in its last 14 home games dating back to Dec. 27, 2025. The Sabres are 10-4-0 in that span.
