- **Wyatt Johnston** scored his 32nd goal of the season, which matched his career high that he set in 2023-24.
- **Johnston's** goal was his 70th point of the season, making him the first player in Stars team history to have 70 points in a season at age 21 or younger according to NHL Stats.
- **Brendan Smith** scored a second-period goal which was his first with the Stars and the second shorthanded goal of his career.
- **Smith** is the 19th player in franchise history to score his first goal with the team while shorthanded according to NHL Stats.
- **Colin Blackwell's** shorthanded assist was his 11th helper of the season, which set a career high for the forward.

### GAME NOTES

#### THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW

- Tonight is the second and final game that the Stars will play against the Red Wings this season and the first time they are playing in Detroit this year. The Stars won the two teams' previous meeting on Jan. 19 4-1.
- The Stars enter tonight's game with a 50-24-6 record for 106 points and a .663 points percentage. Their 50 wins were tied for the second-most in the NHL and their point total and points percentage ranked fourth in the NHL this season entering play Sunday.
- **Jamie Benn** enters tonight's game one goal shy of scoring his 400th career goal. When he reaches the milestone, he will become...
  - The second player in franchise history to score 400 goals, joining Mike Modano (557). 438 of Modano's 557 goals were scored with the Star after the team relocated to Dallas.
  - The second player drafted in 2007 to score 400 goals, with the other being Detroit's Patrick Kane (492).
  - The 10th active skater to score 400 career goals.
- Entering play Sunday, the Stars ranked in the top five in the NHL this season in goals for per game (3.38, fourth) and in goals against per game (2.64, fifth).

### PLAYOFF BOUND

- Dallas became the third team to clinch a berth to the 2025 Stanley Cup Playoffs with their 5-1 win over the Kraken in their game on March 29.

- 2024-25 season marks the 37th postseason appearance in franchise history and their fifth time in the past five seasons – tied for the most among all teams in that span according to NHL Stats.
- The Stars have made the Conference Finals in each of their past two postseasons and can become the fifth team in the past 20 years to do so in three straight (also TBL, CHI, LAK & DET) according to NHL Stats.
- The Stars have won nine series in the past 10 years, tied with the Penguins for the third most in the NHL in that span according to NHL Stats behind only the Lightning (18) and Golden Knights (11).
- The Stars are set to face off against the Colorado Avalanche in the first round of the 2025 Stanley Cup Playoffs.

## CLIPPING THE WINGS

- Dallas is 122-112-38 all-time vs. Detroit, including a 52-68-16 mark on the road.
- The Stars enter tonight's contest with eight consecutive wins against Detroit dating back to April 24, 2021, including earning wins in their last four games played at Little Caesars Arena.
- **Matt Duchene** enters tonight's matchup riding a three-game point streak against the Red Wings, earning four points (1-3-4) in those games. **Duchene** leads active Stars in points (16-19-35) in 41 career games vs. Detroit.
- **Jason Robertson** rides his longest active point streak against a single opponent (also 11 vs. CGY) entering tonight's contest with 19 points (9-10-19) in his last 11 games against Detroit. **Robertson** has earned points in 12 of his 13 career games played against the Red Wings. Dallas is 10-2-0 when **Robertson** has tallied at least one point vs. Detroit.
- **Evgenii Dadonov** has 10 points (4-6-10) in 19 career games against the Red Wings.
- **Esa Lindell** has six points (4-2-6) in his last six games played vs. Detroit. In all, **Lindell** has 17 points (5-12-17) in 23 career games against the Red Wings.
  - His 17 career points against Detroit is his highest point total scored against a single opponent during his career.
- **Roope Hintz** enters tonight's game riding a three-game point streak vs. Detroit, earning 10 points (3-7-10) in those games. In all, **Hintz** has 22 points (10-12-22) in 14 career games vs. Detroit.
- **Mikko Rantanen** has registered 19 points (2-17-19) in 15 career games against the Red Wings, including having seven points (1-6-7) in his last five games against them.
- **Mikael Granlund** enters tonight's matchup riding a five-game point streak vs. Detroit, earning seven points (2-5-7) during that span. In all, **Granlund** has recorded 20 points (9-11-20) in 32 career games against the Red Wings.
- **Jake Oettinger** is 8-2-0 with a 2.57 goals-against average and .904 save percentage in 10 career appearances against the Red Wings. **Oettinger** enters tonight's contest earning wins in six consecutive games vs. Detroit.

## NOW YOU CECI ME, NOW YOU DON'T

- Dallas' last game on April 12 against Utah was **Cody Ceci's** 83rd game played this season – he appeared in 54 regular-season games with the Sharks prior to being traded to Dallas, where he has played in 29 games with the Stars.
- If **Ceci** were to play in both of Dallas' two remaining games, he would become just the ninth player in NHL history to play in at least 85 games during a regular season, joining Tyson Barrie (2022-23), Rem Murray (2002-03), Bill Guerin (2000-01), Glenn Anderson (1993-94), Bob Kudelski (1993-94), Mark Lamb (1993-94), Joe Reekie (1993-94) and Jimmy Carson (1992-93).
- In 25 games since the Four Nations break (since Feb. 22), the Stars have outscored their opponents 29-14 at even strength when **Ceci** has been on the ice. His plus-15 on-ice even-strength goal differential was tied for the fourth-best mark in the NHL during that span entering play Sunday.
- In all this season, **Ceci** has totaled 23 points (4-19-23) in 83 games, which makes the 2024-25 campaign the fifth-highest scoring season of his 12-year career.

## ROAD WARRIORS

- The Stars enter tonight's matchup with the Red Wings having earned at least a point each of the last six games that they have played on the road. A win or overtime loss would give the Stars points in seven consecutive road games for the first time since the team won seven straight road games from March 5 to 30, 2024.
- In all, the Stars have a 22-14-3 record when playing on the road this year, which is tied for the seventh-most road wins in a single season in franchise history.
- **Matt Duchene** leads the Stars in road scoring this season, totaling 45 points (17-28-45) in 39 games. His 45 road points were tied for seventh in the NHL this season entering play Sunday.
  - **Duchene's** 28 road assists this season are already a career high and his 45 road points are the second-most of his 16-year NHL career, one shy of his career high that he set in 2021-22.
- **Mikael Granlund** has recorded 41 points (14-27-41) in 35 road games this season, which includes notching 11 points (3-8-11) in 15 road games with this Stars.
  - **Granlund's** 14 goals, 27 assists and 41 points on the road this season are already career bests.
- **Mikko Rantanen** has 43 points (16-27-43) in 39 road games this season, including tallying 11 points (4-7-11) in nine road games since being acquired by the Stars.
- **Rantanen** and **Granlund** tied for 11th and ranked 13th, respectively, in road scoring this season entering play Sunday.
- **Jason Robertson** has been playing at a point-per-game pace on the road since Nov. 3, totaling 34 points (17-17-34) in 34 games played.
  - **Robertson's** 20 road goals this year were tied for seventh in the NHL entering play Sunday.

- Since Jan. 10, **Robertson** has scored 15 goals on the road, which topped the NHL during that span entering play Sunday and were three more than the second ranked player (Leon Draisaitl and Alex Tuch; 12 each).
- Wyatt Johnston** has been playing at a point-per-game pace on the road since Jan. 13, totaling 19 points (10-9-19) in 19 games played.
- Roope Hintz** has 17 points (3-14-17) in the last 17 games he has played on the road dating back to Jan. 12.
- Thoams Harley** has 10 points (5-5-9) in his last 14 games played on the road dating back to Feb. 7. His 10 road points during that span were tied for the seventh-most among all NHL defensemen entering play Sunday.
- Mason Marchment** has nine points (2-7-9) in his last nine road games played and enters today's game riding a four-game road point streak.
- Casey DeSmith** has won each of the last six games that he has played on the road dating back to Jan. 25, posting a .955 save percentage and a 1.50 goals-against average during that span. His save percentage and goals-against average on the road since Jan. 25 ranked second and third, respectively, in the NHL entering play Sunday among goaltenders who have played in at least two road games during that span.
  - His six road wins since Jan. 25 were tied for the third-most in the NHL entering play Sunday.
  - DeSmith's** six-game road win streak is the longest such streak of his career.

## CLEAN SWEEP

- With a win tonight over the Red Wings, the Stars would earn their ninth series sweep of the season. They have previously won each of the games that they have played against the Boston Bruins (2-0-0), Calgary Flames (3-0-0), New Jersey Devils (2-0-0), New York Islanders (2-0-0), Philadelphia Flyers (2-0-0), San Jose Sharks (3-0-0), Seattle Kraken (3-0-0) and St. Louis Blues (3-0-0).
- The 2024-25 season is already the third consecutive year in which the Stars have had at least eight series sweeps, after logging 12 in 2023-24 and 10 in 2022-23.
- A Dallas victory tonight would also give the Stars their 14th series win of the season. In addition to the teams listed above, the Stars have also won their season series against the Chicago Blackhawks (3-1-0), Edmonton Oilers (2-1-0), Utah Hockey Club (3-1-0), Vancouver Canucks (2-0-1) and Vegas Golden Knights (2-1-0).

## I WANNA BE LIKE MIKE

- Dallas' last game on April 12 vs. Utah marked the 900th regular-season game of **Mikael Granlund's** career.
  - He is the 11th Finnish player in NHL history and the 10th skater from the 2010 NHL Draft class to reach the 900-game milestone.
- Mikael Granlund** had a three-point outing (1-2-3) in Dallas' game on April 8 against Vancouver and now has 12 points (6-6-12) in his last 14 games played dating back to March 18.
  - Granlund's** performance against the Canucks was his third three-point game of the season and his first as a member of the Stars.
- Granlund's** six goals since March 18 are tied for the second-most of any Stars skater during that span and his 12 points are tied for fifth on the team.
- Additionally, since March 18 the Stars have outscored their opponents 11-5 at even strength when **Granlund** has been on the ice. His plus-6 even-strength on-ice goal differential was tied for the third-best mark on Dallas' roster during that span, trailing only **Thomas Harley** (plus-10) and **Cody Ceci** (plus-7).
- Granlund's** goal against the Canucks was his 22nd of the season, which is his second-highest total in a single season in his career, trailing only the 26 goals he scored with the Minnesota Wild in 2016-17.
- The 2024-25 season is already the third-highest scoring season of **Granlund's** 13-year career, and he enters tonight's game three points shy of matching his career high of 69 that he set in 2016-17.

## BIKER GANG

- Thomas Harley** has 27 points (9-18-27) in his last 29 games played dating back to Jan. 31, which ranks fifth on Dallas' roster during that span.
  - Harley's** 27 points (9-18-27) since Jan. 31 were the fourth-most during that span among all NHL defensemen entering play Sunday.
- Harley** tallied his 50th point of the season with an assist against the Canucks on April 8, making him the third Stars defenseman in the last 10 years to reach the 50-point plateau, joining **Miro Heiskanen** (2022-23 and 2023-24) and John Klingberg (2015-16 and 2017-18).
  - Harley's** assist also allowed him to tie Gary Sargen (71) for 25th-most assists by a defenseman in franchise history.
- Harley** set a career high with his 16th goal of the season in Dallas' game on April 6 against the Wild. His 16 goals this year are tied for the sixth-most by a Stars defenseman in a single season in franchise history and were tied for the sixth-most among all NHL defensemen this year entering play Sunday.
- Harley's** assist against Pittsburgh on April 5 was his 33rd assist and 48th point of the season, both of which set career highs for the defenseman.
- Since Jan. 31 – Dallas' first game without **Miro Heiskanen** – **Harley** has been averaging 24:58 of ice time per game, which tops all Stars skaters and ranked ninth in the NHL entering play Sunday.
  - Prior to Jan. 31, **Harley** was averaging 22:27 of ice time per game.



- **Harley** skated a career-high 31:11 in Dallas' game on March 20 against the Tampa Bay Lightning. It was the highest time on ice total by a Stars skater in a regular-season game since **Heiskanen** skated 32:01 on April 11, 2021 against the Nashville Predators.
- When **Harley** has been on the ice during even-strength play this season, the Stars have outscored their opponents 93-58. His plus-35 on-ice even-strength goal differential was tied for the fourth-best mark in the NHL this season entering play Sunday.
- **Harley** recorded the 100th point of his NHL career with an assist in Dallas' March 26 game against the Oilers, making him the third defenseman drafted in 2019 to reach the 100-point milestone, joining Detroit's Moritz Seider and Buffalo's Bowen Byram. He also became the 24th defenseman in franchise history to total 100 points with the Stars.
- **Harley's** 100th career point came in his 188th career regular-season games, making him the fourth-fastest defenseman in Stars/North Stars history to record 100 career points according to NHL Stats, following John Klingberg (145 GP), Craig Hartsburg (170 GP) and Brad Maxwell (170 GP).
- **Harley** matched his single-game career high with three points (1-2-3) in Dallas' March 18 game against the Ducks, surpassing Larry Murphy (93) for the 25th-most points by a defenseman in team history.
  - In that game, the Stars outshot the Ducks 15-2 when **Harley** was on the ice during 5-on-5 play according to Natural Stat Trick.
- **Harley's** game-winning goal in Dallas' March 22 game against the Flyers came just nine seconds into overtime, which set a record for the quickest overtime goal in franchise history according to NHL Stats.
- **Harley** is one of four defensemen this season to score two overtime goals. In total, he has scored five overtime goals since the start of 2023-24, which leads all NHL defensemen and is tied for fifth in the NHL.
- **Harley's** two-goal performance against the Flyers brought his season total up to 15, making him the third defenseman in franchise history to record consecutive 15-goal seasons according to NHL Stats, joining Phillippe Boucher (2 from 2005-06 – 2006-07) and Lou Nanne (1971-72 – 1972-73).

## POWER UP

- Since Jan. 1, the Stars have gone 37-for-123 on the power play for a 30.1 percent success rate, which was the third-best mark in the NHL during that span entering play Sunday.
- The team's 37 power-play goals since Jan. 1 were the most in the NHL during that span entering play Sunday.
- **Wyatt Johnston** has scored nine power-play goals since Jan. 1, which was tied for the most in the NHL during that span entering play Sunday.
- The Stars went a perfect 4-for-4 on the power play in their game on March 2 against the Blues, marking the first time that they have scored four power-play goals in a game since Nov. 12, 2023.
- Their performance against the Blues also was the first time in Stars team history that the team had a 100 percent success rate on the power play in a single game while scoring at least four power-play goals.
- In all this season, the Stars have had three games in which they have scored at least three power-play goals – Oct. 24 at Boston (3), March 2 vs. St. Louis (4) and April 8 vs. Vancouver (3).

## THIRTY, FLIRTY AND THRIVING

- The Stars enter tonight's game with four players that have scored at least 30 goals this season: **Jason Robertson** (35), **Mikko Rantanen** (32), **Wyatt Johnston** (32) and **Matt Duchene** (30).
  - The 2024-25 campaign marks the first time the Stars' roster has housed four 30-goal scorers since the 1992-93 season when Russ Courtnall (36), Ulf Dahlen (35), Dave Gagner (33) and Mike Modano (33) all scored at least 30 goals.
- Entering play Sunday, the Stars and the Tampa Bay Lightning were the only two teams this season to have four 30-goal scorers on its roster.
- Entering tonight's game, **Roope Hintz** is two goals shy of reaching the 30-goal mark. If he were to score 30 goals by the end of the regular season, it would mark the first time in franchise history that the Stars would have five 30-goals scorers on its roster.
- Additionally, the Stars could become the first team to have five 30-goal scorers on its roster since the Pittsburgh Penguins and Detroit Red Wings, who both did so during the 1992-93 season according to NHL Stats. Please note that this includes players who did not score all 30+ of their goals with one team.

## CAREER YEARS ARE NEAR

- With two games remaining in the 2024-25 regular-season, several Stars players are withing striking distance of setting or matching various career highs.

## IT TAKES TWO

- **Jake Oettinger** has an 20-7-3 record in his last 30 games played dating back to Dec. 29, posting a .915 save percentage and a 2.52 goals-against average during that span.
  - His 20 wins since Dec. 29 were the fourth-most in the NHL during that span entering play Sunday.
- **Oettinger** made a season-high 41 saves in Dallas' March 26 game, a 4-3 win over the Oilers. The Stars were outshot 44-24 in that game.
- **Oettinger** made 33 saves for his 12th career shutout in Dallas' March 24 game, a 3-0 win over Minnesota, which tied Jon Casey for the sixth-most shutouts in franchise history.
  - **Oettinger** saved 5.74 goals above expected in the game according to MoneyPuck.com.
- **Oettinger's** shutout was also the 12th of his career, which tied teammate **Casey DeSmith** for the fifth-most by a U.S.-born goaltender in NHL history according to NHL Stats.
- The Stars' victory over the Wild was also the 146th win of **Oettinger's** career, which passed Cesare Maniago (145) for the fourth-most wins by a goaltender in franchise history.
- **Oettinger** earned his 30th win of the season in Dallas' game on March 6, a 3-2 overtime win over the Calgary Flames. According to NHL Stats, he became the fourth goaltender in Stars/North Stars history with four or more 30-win seasons, joining Marty Turco (6x), Ed Belfour (4x) and Kari Lehtonen (4x). He also joined Turco (6 from 2002-03 to 2008-09) and Belfour (4 from 1997-98 to 2000-01) as the only netminders to do so in four consecutive campaigns with the franchise.
- **Casey DeSmith** has posted an 8-2-1 record in his last 11 games played dating back to Jan. 25 against the St. Louis Blues, posting a .920 save percentage and a 2.64 goals-against average in those contests.
- **DeSmith** made 46 saves in Dallas' March 27 game against the Flames, a 5-2 Stars win. His 46 saves were the most by a Dallas netminder this season and the third-most in a single game in **DeSmith's** career.
- In all this season, **DeSmith** has saved .61 goals above expected per 60, which was the seventh-best mark in the NHL this season entering play Sunday among netminders that have played in more than five games.
- In all, **Oettinger** and **DeSmith** have combined for a .909 save percentage this season, which was the second-best mark of any team in the NHL this season entering play Sunday. The duo's 2.62 goals-against average this season ranked fifth in the NHL this year entering play Sunday.

## ONE FOR THE HISTORY BOOKS

- **Thomas Harley** is four goals shy of surpassing Barry Gibbs (35) for the 15th-most goals by a defenseman in franchise history.
- **Roope Hintz** is one goal shy of tying Danny Grant (176) for 15th-most goals in franchise history.
- **Esa Lindell** is two assists shy of tying Stephane Robidas (165) for 10th-most assists by a defenseman in franchise history.
- **Esa Lindell** is eight points shy of tying Lou Nanne (225) for 10th most points by a defenseman in franchise history.
- **Jason Robertson** is eight goals shy of tying Danny Grant (176) for 15th-most goals in franchise history.
- **Wyatt Johnston** is one goal shy of tying Radek Faksa (89) for 30th-most goals in team history.

## CONNECTIONS

- Stars GM **Jim Nill** played for the Red Wings from 1987-88 to 1989-90. Nill also held multiple positions in the Red Wings organization from 1994-95 to 2012-23, winning four Stanley Cups during his time there.
- Stars defenseman **Brendan Smith** was selected 27th overall by the Red Wings in the 2007 NHL draft. He played for Detroit from 2011-12 to 2016-17.
- Red Wings forward Craig Smith played for the Dallas Stars during the 2023-24 season, playing in 75 games.
- Stars forwards **Matt Duchene** and **Mikko Rantanen** and Red Wings forward J.T. Compher all played for the Colorado Avalanche. Duchene and Compher played together during the 2016-17 and 2017-18 seasons and Rantanen and Compher from 2016-17 to 2022-23.
- Stars Player Development Assistant **Jordie Benn** and Red Wings forward Andrew Copp were teammates in Winnipeg during the 2020-21 season.
- Stars defenseman **Nils Lundkvist** and Red Wings forwards Andrew Copp and Tyler Motte skated together while with the New York Rangers in 2021-22.
- Stars defenseman **Ilya Lyubushkin** and Red Wings forward Christian Fischer played together in Arizona from 2018-19 to 2021-22.
- Stars forward **Colin Blackwell** and Special Assistant to the President **Marty Turco** played with Red Wings forward Patrick Kane in Chicago. Blackwell and Kane were teammates during the 2022-23 season, while Turco and Kane were members of the Blackhawks in 2010-11.

- Stars defenseman **Matt Dumba** and Red Wings forward Tyler Motte were teammates in Tampa Bay during the 2023-24 season.
- Stars Player Development Assistant **Jordie Benn** and Red Wings forward Tyler Motte skated together in Vancouver during the 2019-20 and 2020-21 seasons.
- Stars VP of Cultural Growth & Strategy **Al Montoya** and Red Wings defenseman Ben Chiarot played one game together as members of the Winnipeg Jets during the 2012-13 season.
- Stars forward **Mason Marchment** and Red Wings defenseman Ben Chiarot played together during the 2020-21 season with the Florida Panthers.
- Stars Player Development Assistant **Jordie Benn** and Red Wings defenseman Erik Gustafsson were both members of the Toronto Maple Leafs in 2022-23.
- Stars forwards **Mason Marchment** and **Colin Blackwell** and defenseman **Ilya Lyubushkin** played with Red Wings defenseman Justin Holl in Toronto. Marchment and Holl shared the ice for a handful of games in 2019-20, while Blackwell, Lyubushkin and Holl all played for Toronto in 2021-22.
- Stars defenseman **Ilya Lyubushkin** and Red Wings defenseman William Lagesson were teammates in Toronto during the 2023-24 season.
- Stars goaltender **Jake Oettinger** and Red Wings forward Dylan Larkin were members of Team USA during the 2025 Four Nations tournament.
- Stars forwards **Matt Duchene**, **Colin Blackwell**, and **Mikael Granlund** all played in Nashville alongside Red Wings forwards Craig Smith and Austin Watson.
