

- Forward **Ryan Conmy** led the University of New Hampshire in points, finishing the season with 33 (15-18=33) in 34 games. After recording an 11-game point streak with six goals and eight assists for 14 points (Nov. 9-Jan. 4) en route to setting new career highs in his sophomore season, Conmy was named to the Hobey Baker Ballot for the second consecutive occasion.
- Goaltender Hampton Slukynsky finished his freshman season at Western Michigan University tied for the seventh lowest goals
 against average (GAA) with a 1.92 over 23 appearances on the campaign.

- Forward **Liam Greentree** finished the regular season third in the Ontario Hockey League (OHL) in total points (49-70=119) behind only teammate **Ilya Protas** (50-74=124) and Saginaw's **Michael Misa** (62-72=134).
- Through 189 regular season games played, Greentree's 254 career points (110-144=254), the Spitfires' captain are the seventh most in franchise history. He is one of three Windsor players to have recorded at least 250 career points for the team since the year 2000, joining **Ryan Ellis** (73-240=313), who played 226 games from 2007-2011, and **Taylor Hall** (123-157=280), who wore a Spitfires sweater for 183 contests from 2007-2010.
- Goaltender **Carter George** maintained a .909 SV% through 47 appearances on the year, the seventh best among 43 OHL goalies with at least 10 regular season games played.

- The Windsor Spitfires defeated the Soo Greyhounds four games to one and advance to the second round to face the Kitchener Rangers. Greentree netted five points (3-2=5) with a hat trick to close out the series in Game 5.
- Forward **Koehn Ziemmer** averaged a point-per-game through the Cougars' trip to the WHL Playoffs, which ended with a 4-2 defeat in Game 7 to Portland. Ziemmer was named the First Star of that contest and concludes his juniors career as Prince George's all-time leading goal-scorer, tallying 128 goals in 244 regular season games played over parts of six seasons.
