## AT A GLANCE

#### **KEEPERS OF THE CASTLE**

After opening the 2025 calendar year with a 3-0 shutout victory over the New Jersey Devils, the Kings eclipsed the halfway mark of the 2024-25 season limiting their opponents to a league-low 2.41 goals-against per game (GA/GP) and 24.9 shots-against per game (SA/GP), while allowing just 99 goals through 41 contests thus far in the campaign. The Kings are the only team in the NHL to have conceded fewer than 100 goals against at this stage of the campaign.

#### **ROGER THAT, DARC**

Goaltender **Darcy Kuemper** enters tomorrow's matchup at Rogers Center having helped his team pick up points in 13 of his past 15 starts against the Vancouver Canucks, dating back to March 7, 2018, with the Arizona Coyotes. The 34-year-old has collected wins in nine of his past 12 outings against the franchise. In 22 career starts against the Canucks, Kuemper has compiled a 13-7-2 record with a .921 save-percentage (SV%) and 2.32 goals against average (GAA) with one shutout. The netminder has been especially strong on the road against the Canucks, posting a 7-2-1 record in 10 starts with a .930 SV% and 2.23 GAA. Kuemper's seven victories as a visitor in Vancouver are tied for his most road wins against any franchise in his career (7-3-1 vs. EDM). Since making his NHL debut on Feb. 12, 2013, against the Canucks at Rogers Center, no other active goalie has recorded more regular season wins as a visitor in the building.
