BLUE JACKETS NOTES

JACKETS OFFENSIVE OUTPUT

The club has recorded 95 goals (not including SO goals) in the first 28 games this season. It's the second-most goals scored through the opening 28 contests of a campaign in franchise history, five shy of the 100 recorded in 2018-19. CBJ, who averaged a franchise-best 3.15 goals-for/game during the 2021-22 season, rank seventh in the NHL this season, averaging 3.39 goals-for/game. Columbus' 95 goals scored this season are the ninth-most in the NHL this season. The team has scored in all three periods in six of the last 10 games, including tying the franchise record by scoring in 16-consecutive periods in regulation from Nov. 18-Dec. 1 (Feb. 2-13, 2021). By scoring in all three periods at Edmonton on Dec. 5, it marked the 11th time this season the club accomplished the feat. Columbus has scored goals in 58-of-the-84 periods played in regulation this season with 27 multi-goal frames after scoring two goals in the third period on Tuesday vs. Philadelphia. CBJ have had 18 different players record a goal this season, while 22 of the 23 skaters have recorded a point.

HOME AT NATIONWIDE

Columbus opened its three-game homestand with a 5-3 loss to Philadelphia on Tuesday snapping a five-game points streak (4-0-1) in defeat. CBJ are 7-2-1 in the last 10 at Nationwide Arena since Oct. 22. The Blue Jackets are also 8-4-1 (17 points) at Nationwide Arena this season, recording the second-most wins (tied) and fourth-most points through the first 13 home games of a season in club history. Since Oct. 22 vs. Toronto, Columbus ranks fourth-T (Toronto) in points percentage at home (.750%). The Jackets have outscored opponents 44-32 over that stretch and are second in the NHL in averaging 4.40 GF/GP (Carolina, 4.50). CBJ trail only Carolina (4.21) for first in the league in goals-for/game (4.15) at home this season and rank fifth in the league in goals with 54.

CBJ, PARTY OF SIX (OR MORE)

The Blue Jackets have recorded six goals or more in seven of the 28 games played this season, including beating Chicago 6-3 on Dec. 1. It's tied for the second-most (Florida and Washington) among all teams, trailing only Winnipeg (9). It's the fifth time in franchise history that CBJ have scored at least six goals in seven or more contests in a season. Accomplished in the first 23 games, it's also the fastest the team recorded seven six-plus goal outings, surpassing the 2018-19 campaign when CBJ reached the mark in the 46th game on their way to finishing with a club-record 11 six-goal outings. The club had eight instances of six or more goals in 2023-24.

BUSY DECEMBER

CBJ play 16 games (nine on the road) in the month of December, including 13 before the holiday break from Dec. 24-26. The Jackets open the month with their second five-game road trip (Nov. 2-12) of the season from Dec. 1-8, playing at Chicago, Calgary, Edmonton, Vancouver and Winnipeg. Columbus also plays three of their 12 back-to-back sets of the season in the month (Dec. 5 at EDM & Dec. 6 at VAN; Dec. 14 vs. ANA & Dec. 15 at CAR; Dec. 27 vs. BOS & Dec. 28 at BOS). The club also plays six games against Metro Division foes, including twice each against Carolina and Philadelphia.

NEW PRESIDENT AND GENERAL MANAGER

Don Waddell was named General Manager and President of Hockey Operations for the Blue Jackets on May 28. Waddell spent ten years with the Carolina Hurricanes, serving as team president from 2014-18 and team president and general manager from 2018-24. Under Waddell, Carolina ranked second in the NHL in points percentage, third in wins, advanced to the Stanley Cup Playoffs each year, and won three division titles with a record of 278-130-44 (.664 pct) in 452 games. Prior to Carolina, Waddell also won a Stanley Cup with the Detroit Red Wings as an assistant general manager in 1998 and served as vice president of hockey operations and general manager of the Atlanta Thrashers from 1999-2010 and team president from 2010-11.

EVASON BEHIND THE BENCH

Dean Evason was named head coach of the Blue Jackets on July 22 after previously serving as the head coach for the Minnesota Wild. Evason spent six seasons as a member of the Wild organization. With the Wild, he posted a 147-77-27 record in 251 games from Feb. 14, 2020, through Nov. 27, 2023. His .639 points percentage entering the 2024-25 campaign ranked fifth among active coaches with 250 or more contests behind the bench. Evason was also a finalist for the Jack Adams award in 2020-21 and finished fourth in voting for the award in 2021-22.

LEADING THE CHARGE

CBJ have four players that are averaging 0.85 points-per-game or better to start the season: F **Kent Johnson** (1.14, 9-7-16 in 14 GP), D **Zach Werenski** (1.04; 9-20-29 in 28 GP), RW **Kirill Marchenko** (0.96, 10-17-27 in 28 GP) and C **Sean Monahan** (0.86, 9-15-24 in 28 GP). Johnson leads the team in multi-goal outings this season (2) and has posted multi-point efforts in two-straight contests (3-1-4). He also posted points in his first nine contests to become the second player in club history to record accomplish the feat (Ryan Johansen, 10 GP in 2014-15). The trio of Marchenko, Monahan and Werenski all reached the 20-point mark in the 20th game of the season on Nov. 23 vs. Carolina, the first time in club history that three players posted 20-plus points in the first 20 games of a campaign. Marchenko leads the team in goals and multi-point efforts (8) and has recorded 4-7-11 in his past 10 contests.

MONAHAN'S MOMENTUM

C **Sean Monahan**, who has collected points in two-straight (1-1-2) and 3-10-13 in the last 13 games, leads the club in multi-assist efforts (tied) and ranks second-T in goals and multi-point outings and third in assists and points with 9-15-24, four multi-assist and seven multi-point contests in 28 games. By notching an assist against Carolina on Nov. 23, he became just the third player in franchise history to post 20 points or more in his first 20 games with the club (Andrew Cassels, 5-18-23 in 2002 & Johnny Gaudreau, 7-13-20, in 2022). He posted his eighth career four-point outing on Nov. 21 against Tampa Bay (1-3-4). The forward ranks seventh in the NHL in face-off wins (304-of-575; 52.9 pct.) after winning 13-of-16 faceoffs on Tuesday.

ZACH ATTACK

D **Zach Werenski**, who was named to the Team USA roster for the 4 Nations Face-Off on Dec. 4, has posted points in three of the last four games (1-2-3) and 12 of the past 15 played this season (6-14-20). He set club records for longest assist and point streaks by a defenseman and tied the franchise mark for all skaters for longest assist streak with 5-11-16 in eight consecutive games from Nov. 15-Dec. 1. He finished the month of November with 5-11-16 in 13 games, setting club records for most assists (tied, third time) and points by a defenseman in a single month. The previous record of points was 14 recorded by Werenski (Mar. 2024) and Seth Jones (Mar. 2018).

The Grosse Pointe, Michigan native has recorded 99-232-331 in 514 career contests with CBJ, trailing Nick Foligno by three points for fourth all-time on the club's scoring list. He also became the 10th player – and fourth defenseman – to play in 500 career games with the Blue Jackets on Nov. 10 at Anaheim. Werenski tallied his 100th career power play point on Nov. 23 against the Hurricanes to become the third player in club history to reach the mark (Rick Nash, 182 & David Vyborny, 126).

Werenski leads the NHL in ice time as well as ranks tied for first among league blueliners in goals and shots on goal, third in points and sixth-T in assists with 9-20-29 and 96 shots on 26:06 of ice time in 28 contests this season. He notched his 60th-career multi-point game against the Penguins on Nov. 15 to become the fifth player in franchise history to reach the mark. The 27-year-old recorded his 34th career multi-assist outing against Chicago on Dec. 1, tying David Vyborny for the second-most in franchise history and trailing only Nash (39). He is the Blue Jackets' all-time leader in goals, assists and points by a defenseman and ranks sixth among NHL blueliners in goals since making his NHL debut in 2016-17 (NSH's Roman Josi, 136). He set single-season franchise records for assists (James Wisniewski, 44 in 2013-14) and points by a defenseman (tied with Seth Jones, 57 in 2017-18) with 11-46-57 in 70 contests in 2023-24.

HONORING THE GAUDREAUS

The Blue Jackets are honoring the memory of forward Johnny Gaudreau and his brother, Matthew during the 2024-25 season with a special "13 & 21" helmet sticker and "13" patch on their jerseys. The home opener against the defending Stanley Cup champion Florida Panthers on Oct. 15 included a pre-game video and ceremony. Fans were also able to visit a special tribute on the main concourse that includes jerseys and items placed at Nationwide Arena in remembrance of the brothers. Everyone in attendance received a "13" patch to match the one Blue Jackets players are wearing on their jerseys throughout the season. Fans also had opportunities to help raise funds for the John and Matthew Gaudreau Foundation throughout the evening with a jersey auction, 50/50 raffle, gameday auction and Gaudreau lapel pin sale.
