

Selected by the Rangers with the second overall pick in the 2019 NHL Draft, Kakko collected career highs in goals (18), assists (22), points (40) and plus/minus rating (\pm 12) last season. He was one of seven Blueshirts to play in all 82 games during the campaign and one of eight on the team to record \pm 0+points. All 18 of his goals came at even strength, tied for the fourth-most on the team. Kakko is the highest European-born player drafted by the Rangers in franchise history.
