

Selected by the Rangers with the second overall pick in the 2019 NHL Draft, Kakko collected career highs in goals (18), assists (22), points (40) and plus/minus rating (+12) last season. He was one of seven Blueshirts to play in all 82 games during the campaign and one of eight on the team to record 40+points. All 18 of his goals came at even strength, tied for the fourth-most on the team. Kakko is the highest European-born player drafted by the Rangers in franchise history.
