THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW

Buffalo has defeated New York in six of the last eight matchups between the two teams, including wins in four of the past five.

In 2022-23, the Sabres earned wins in two of their three games against the Islanders.



Jeff Skinner has tallied four points (2+2) in his last four games against the Islanders.

Skinner leads all Sabres skaters in games played (44), goals (13), assists (12) and points (25) against the Islanders.

A goal in tonight's game would give **Kyle Okposo** a goal in three consecutive games against New York.

Dylan Cozens has registered six points (2+4) in his last five contests against the Islanders,

including one point in each of his last three.

Erik Johnson has a career plus/minus rating of plus-10 in 19 games against the Islanders in his career.



ON THE ROAD AGAIN

Tonight's game is Buffalo's first road contest of the 2023-24 season.

The Sabres played to a road record of 25-13-3 in 2022-23, earning 53 points away from home.

In 2022-23, Buffalo ranked fifth among all NHL teams in goals scored on the road (148), and ranked second among all NHL teams in first-period goals in road games (47).

Buffalo ranked fourth among all NHL teams in total takeaways in road contests (292) last season.

On the road in 2022-23, **Tage Thompson** led all Sabres skaters in goals (23), points (48), points per game (1.23), even-strength goals (16), power-play goals (7) and shots (150).

Thompson's 23 goals were tied for the sixth-most road goals in a single season by a Sabres skater and the most since Thomas Vanek (23) in 2008-09.

ON THIS DATE

The Sabres are 10-10-1 all-time on October 14.

October 14, 1971: Mike Robitaille scores his first goal as a member of the Sabres.

October 14, 1974: Buffalo trades Gerry Meehan and Mike Robitaille to Vancouver for Jocelyn Guevremont and Bryan McSheffrey.

October 14, 2006: Chris Drury records his first and only hat trick in a Sabres uniform in a 7-4 win over the New York Rangers.



BENNY THE KID

Zach Benson (18 years, 153 days) became the second-youngest Sabres skater to appear in a regular-season game on Oct. 12 vs. NY Rangers, behind only Pierre Turgeon (18 years, 41 days).

Benson also became the first Sabres skater since Rasmus Dahlin, who played in 82 games with Buffalo before turning 19, to appear in a game at age 18 or younger.

A goal in tonight's game would make **Benson** the second-youngest Sabres skater in franchise history to record a goal in a game and the 12th skater aged 18 or younger to do so.
