# **TOP NOTES**

Buffalo's nine goals in tonight's game are tied for the most in a single game by any NHL team this season. It marked the most goals the Sabres have recorded in a single game since their 9-3 victory over Toronto on Dec. 21, 2023.

Josh Doan's first goal marked the first goal he has scored against Chicago in his career. His second goal of the game marked his third-career multi-goal game and his first since Oct. 18. 2025 vs. Florida (2+0).

**Tage Thompson** recorded two points (1+1) tonight and he has registered 12 points (7+5) in his last eight games against the Blackhawks. Tonight marked **Thompson's** seventh multi-point game of the season, the most among all Sabres skaters.

**Alex Tuch's** assist on **Doan's** first goal extended his point streak against Chicago to four games. In that span, **Tuch** has registered nine points (3+6). It marked the first point streak of four or more games by a Sabres skater against Chicago since JJ Peterka from (Nov. 19, 2023 to Dec. 27, 2024; four games).

**Tuch** posted four assists tonight and he notched his fourth assist of the night on **Thompson's** goal. It marked the second time he had registered four or more assists in a single game in his career. He last did so on Dec. 21, 2023 vs. Toronto (0+4). It was the second such performance by a Sabres skater this season (Oct. 15 vs. Ottawa: **Zach Benson**. 0+4).

In addition to his goal, **Ryan McLeod** collected an assist on **Bowen Byram's** goal. His goal marked his third multi-point effort of the season. He last recorded multiple points in a game on Oct. 22 vs. Detroit (0+2).

With his goal, **Mattias Samuelsson** set a new single-season career high in goals (5). He is now tied for fifth among all NHL defensemen in goals this season.

**McLeod** and **Samuelsson's** goals came just eight seconds apart, which marked the fastest two goals by two Sabres skaters since Cody Hodgson and Nathan Gerbe scored six seconds apart on April 19, 2013 vs. the New York Rangers.

Rasmus Dahlin's two assists gave him his second four-game assist streak of the season (Oct. 13 to 20; 0+5). In his last eight games against Chicago, **Dahlin** has tallied 11 points (2+9).

**Jason Zucker's** three points (1+2) in tonight's game gave him four points (1+3) in his last two games. It marked his highest point total in a single game since Feb. 22, 2025 vs. the New York Rangers (0+3).
