Egor Chinakhov scored his 14th goal as a member of the Penguins on Sunday and has hit career highs across the board in goals (17), assists (15) and points (32).

- Chinakhov has 14 goals in 33 games with the Penguins after scoring three goals in 29 games with the Columbus Blue Jackets prior to his trade.

Bryan Rust enter tonight's game riding a career-long eight-game point streak, accumulating five goals, seven assists and 12 points since March 10.

MALKIN 1400

Evgeni Malkin enters tonight's game two points away from becoming the third active player to record 1,400 career points.

- Of the 22 players who have 1,400 career points, Malkin, entering his 1,264th career game, is looking to become the 14th-fastest player in NHL history to reach the 1,400-point milestone:
