SAN DIEGO has earned standings points in 12 of their last 18 games (9-6-3).

OLEN ZELLWEGER leads AHL defensemen in PPG (5), while ranking fifth in scoring (11-24=35) and goals and eighth in assists. He also leads rookie blueliners in scoring and goals, while ranking second in assists. Zellweger paces Gulls defensemen in points and goals, while ranking third among San Diego skaters in scoring and assists and tied for fourth in goals. He has 3-6=9 points through his last seven games and 5-8=12 points through his last 11 outings.

TOMAS SUCHANEK ranks second in the AHL with a .928 SV% and ninth with a 2.33 GAA. He is 11-4-3 on the season and has helped the Gulls earn standings points in nine of his last 11 appearances.

CHASE DE LEO leads the Gull in points per game (0.93) while ranking fifth among San Diego leaders in points (11-17=28). He scored his 65th goal as a Gull (PPG) to obtain sole possession of second place on San Diego's all-time goals list. De Leo has 5-7=12 points through his last eight games.

PAVOL REGENDA leads the Gulls with 16 goals on the season and ranks fifth among team leaders in points (16-12=28). He recorded a careerlong six game point/assist streak (1-7=8) Feb. 3-Feb. 20 and has 6-9=15 points through his last 13 outings.

GLEN GAWDIN ranks second among San Diego leaders in points (15-21=36) and goals, while ranking fourth in assist. He has tallied 3-9=12 points through his last eight games.

ANDREW AGOZZINO leads San Diego in scoring (13-28=41) and assists, while ranking third in goals. He had back-to-back multi-point performances Feb. 20 @ Bakersfield (1-1=2) and Feb. 24 vs. Ontario (0-2=2). Agozzino has 5-10=15 points through his last 14 games.

He set a ECHL season-high for points and tied the season-high for goals with his four goals and six points (4-2=6) in Tulsa's 10-4 win Feb. 24 vs. Idaho. McLaughlin is currently riding a five-game point streak (4-6=10) and has 6-8=14 points through his last eight games.

RODWIN DIONICIO was named the OHL Player of the Week (Feb. 19), earning 3-6=9 points in three outings last week. He is tied second in goals (22), third in points per game (1.27), and tied fourth in scoring (22-38=60) among all OHL defensemen.

CUTTER GAUTHIER was named the Hockey East Player of the Week each of the last two weeks, tallying 6-4=10 points through five games. He leads the NCAA in goals (29) and is tied for third in points (29-19=48) with a +20 rating in 31 games at Boston College (Hockey East). He leads the Eagles in goals, PPG (10) and GWG (8). He currently has points in 20 of his last 21 NCAA games (21-17=38). He posted a career-best 14-game point streak Nov. 17-Feb. 9 (11-10=21), the longest in the NCAA this season and longest in Hockey East since 2018-19. Since returning from the WJC, he has recorded 16 goals in 14 games (16-10=26, +15). In February, he has 10-6=16 points in eight contests.

SAM COLANGELO is tied for 10th among NCAA leaders in goals (19) while earning a career-high 19-17=36 points this season. He has helped the Broncos to points in 17 of the last 20 games (13-3-4) while scoring 13-14=27 points in that span.
