TOP NOTES

In his last nine games against Pittsburgh including his two-point performance tonight (1+1), **Tage Thompson** has now notched 10 points (5+5), including at least one point in four straight games against the Penguins. **Thompson** leads all current Sabres skaters in career goals against Pittsburgh (9).

Thompson's goal marked the fourth time this season the Sabres have registered a goal in the first minute of a game. **Thompson** recorded a goal 43 seconds into Buffalo's game on Oct. 16, 2024 at Pittsburgh.

With his assists on **Thompson's** goal and **Mattias Samuelsson's** goal, **Rasmus Dahlin** has registered at least one point in four consecutive games (1+4). His first assist tonight gave him his fifth point streak of four or more games this season.

Including his two points (1+1) tonight, **Alex Tuch** has now recorded eight points (3+5) in his last five games against Pittsburgh, including at least one point in each game in that span. **Tuch** is the first Sabres skater since Kyle Okposo from Nov. 16, 2021 to Dec. 9, 2022 (five games; 3+2) to tally a point streak of five or more games against the Penguins.

Bowen Byram registered an assist on both of **Jiri Kulich's** goals. As a result, **Byram** has now tallied at least one point in each of the three games he has played against Pittsburgh as a member of the Sabres and he has notched five points (0+5) in that span. His assist made him the first Sabres skater since Christian Ehrhoff from Oct. 15, 2011 to Feb. 19, 2012 (0+5) to record four or more assists in their first three games against Pittsburgh with Buffalo.

Kulich's second goal of the game marked his third multi-goal game this season. He has now registered the most even-strength goals (14) by a Sabres rookie since Jack Eichel (16) and Sam Reinhart (15) in 2015-16. He is tied for the second-most 5-on-5 goals (13) by a Sabres rookie since the league began tracking the stat in 2009-10.

Isak Rosen's assist on Samuelsson's goal marked his first NHL point.

Tyson Kozak's goal and assist tonight gave him at least one point in three consecutive games (2+2). It marked the first point streak of three or more games and the first multi-point performance of his career.

The Sabres are now 10-2-0 in their last 12 home contests.
