PRACTICE UPDATE:

- The Stars will hold practice at 12 p.m. CT at Comerica Center (2601 Avenue of the Stars, Frisco, TX 75034) before their flight to Palm Springs, California.

NOTES:

- The Stars have won each of their past four season openers. The franchise's 184 goals for in those contests are the third most among non-Original Six clubs, trailing the Blues (196) and Penguins (186).
- Stars captain **Jamie Benn** played in his 14th season-opening game for the franchise, passing Neal Broten (8-6—14 in 13 GP) for the second most in franchise history (1967-present). Benn trails only Mike Modano (9-13—22 in 20 GP) for the most season openers in franchise history.
- Benn scored the Stars' first goal of 2023-24 and boosted his totals in season openers to seven points (3-4—7) – tied with Stephane Robidas (7) for the sixth-most points in those contests since the club relocated to Dallas in 1993, behind Mike Modano (16), Sergei Zubov (16), Jere Lehtinen (9), Darryl Sydor (8) and Joe Nieuwendyk (8).
- Forwards **Ty Dellandrea** (0-1—1) and **Wyatt Johnston** (0-1—1) picked up their first points of the season with an assist apiece on Benn's goal.
- Defenseman **Miro Heiskanen** led all skaters with 27:53 TOI.
- Goaltender **Jake Oettinger** picked up his 79th career victory with a 23-save effort in Dallas' shootout victory over the Blues. Oettinger turned aside all three shots in overtime and two of three in the shootout.
