THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW

Buffalo is riding a five-game point streak against Minnesota (4–0–1), the longest in franchise history.

The Sabres have earned at least one point in five of their last six road contests against the Wild (4–1–1), including at least one point in each of their last three games in Minnesota.

A point in tonight's game would give Buffalo its longest road point streak against Minnesota.

In Buffalo's last 11 games, **Ukko-Pekka Luukkonen** has made nine starts and has recorded 222 saves on 235 shots (.945) in that span.

In those starts, he has registered a goals-against average of 1.47 and he has recorded three shutouts.

Dylan Cozens has eight points (3+5) in his last eight games.

JJ Peterka has recorded nine points (6+3) in his last nine games, including five goals in his last six games.

Rasmus Dahlin needs one goal to match his previous single-season career high (15), which he set in 78 games in 2022-23.

COOL HAND LUUK

Ukko-Pekka Luukkonen is 7-5-0 in his last 12 starts dating back to Dec. 30 and he has registered a save percentage of .941 and a goals-against average of 1.60 in that span.

Luukkonen ranks first in goals-against average and second in save percentage among all NHL goaltenders who had played in at least five games since Dec. 30.

In that span, **Luukkonen** has recorded three shutouts, the most among all NHL goaltenders.

If **Luukkonen** records one more shutout this season, it will mark the 14th time of a Sabres goaltender recorded five or more shutouts in a single season.

ON THIS DATE

The Sabres are 7-12-6 all-time on February 17.

<u>February 17, 2012:</u> Tyler Myers records his 100th NHL point in his 200th NHL game in a shootout loss to Montreal.

MITTELSTADT MODE

Casey Mittelstadt has registered 43 points (12+31) through Buffalo's first 53 games of 2023-24, which is the most among all Sabres skaters.

He leads all Sabres skaters in even-strength points (37) and assists (31).

Mittelstadt ranks first among all Sabres skaters in primary assists (13) and assists (23) at 5-on-5.

Mittelstadt ranks second among all Sabres skaters in primary assists at all strengths (16), trailing only **Dylan Cozens** (17).

According to Natural Stat Trick, **Mittelstadt** ranks second among all Sabres skaters in takeaways (30) at 5-on-5.
