- Goaltender **Jake Oettinger** recorded his 10th career shutout and became just the third goaltender in franchise history to post as many after debuting with the club. The others: **Marty Turco** (40) and **Jon Casey** (12).
- With his 30th goal of the season, forward **Wyatt Johnston** (30-31—61 in 76 GP) joined **Brian Bellows** (35 in 1982-83 & 41 in 1983-84) as the second player in franchise history to record a 30-goal season prior to their 21st birthday. Johnston has four points (2-2—4) in his past two games and eight points (4-4—8) in his past five.
- Captain **Jamie Benn** (1-0—1) tallied his 19th goal of the season and has points in 16 of his past 20 games overall (10-14—24). With one more goal, Benn will become the eighth player on the team to reach 20 goals this season.
- Forward **Radek Faksa** (1-2—3) tied his career high with three points in tonight's win. The last time he recorded as many in a game was Dec. 31, 2017 vs. San Jose (0-3—3). His third point of the game also marked his 200th career NHL point (89-111—200).
- Forward **Tyler Seguin** (1-0—1) potted his 23rd goal of the 2023-24 campaign with a power-play tally in the second period. Seguin has five points (3-2—5) in his past six games.
- Forward **Sam Steel** (1-1—2) recorded his fourth multi-point performance of the season with a goal and an assist.
- Forward **Craig Smith** (0-2—2) registered his first multi-point game of the season with two assists vs. Edmonton.
