GAME NOTES

THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW

- Tonight is the third and final game that the Stars will play against the Canucks this season and the second time they are playing in Dallas this year. Dallas won their previous two meetings against Vancouver: Defeating the Canucks with a 5-3 win on Jan. 31 in Dallas and earning a 4-1 win against Vancouver on March 9 in Vancouver.
 - A Stars victory tonight would give Dallas a series sweep against Vancouver for the first time since the 2019-20 season.
- The Stars enter tonight's game with a 50-22-5 record for 105 points and a .682 points percentage. Their 50 wins were the second-most in the NHL and their point total and points percentage ranked third in the NHL this season entering play Monday.
- Jamie Benn enters tonight's game one goal shy of scoring his 400th career goal. When he reaches the milestone, he will become...
 - o The second player in franchise history to score 400 goals, joining Mike Modano (557). 438 of Modano's 557 goals were scored with the Star after the team relocated to Dallas.
 - o The second player drafted in 2007 to score 400 goals, with the other being Detroit's Patrick Kane (490).
 - o The 10th active skater to score 400 career goals.
- Mason Marchment has been playing at a point-per-game pace since March 14, totaling 13 points (5-8—13) in 13 games.
- In 22 games since the Four Nations break (since Feb. 22), the Stars have outscored their opponents 27-12 at even strength when **Cody Ceci** has been on the ice. His plus-15 on-ice even-strength goal differential was tied for the fifth-best mark in the NHL during that span entering play Monday.
- Entering play Monday, the Stars were the only team this season to have not lost more than two consecutive games.
- Entering play Monday, the Stars ranked in the top five in the NHL this season in goals for per game (3.40, third) and in goals against per game (2.55, third).

PLAYOFF BOUND

- Dallas became the third team to clinch a berth to the 2025 Stanley Cup Playoffs with their 5-1 win over the Kraken in their game on March 29.
- 2024-25 season marks the 37th postseason appearance in franchise history and their fifth time in the past five seasons tied for the most among all teams in that span according to NHL Stats.
- The Stars have made the Conference Finals in each of their past two postseasons and can become the fifth team in the past 20 years to do so in three straight (also TBL, CHI, LAK & DET) according to NHL Stats.
- The Stars have won nine series in the past 10 years, tied with the Penguins for the third most in the NHL in that span according to NHL Stats behind only the Lightning (18) and Golden Knights (11).

WHALE WATCHING

- Dallas is 100-75-29 all-time vs. Vancouver, including a 55-33-14 mark on home ice.
- Roope Hintz enters tonight's contest riding a three-game point streak against the Canucks, earning seven points (4-3-7) during that span. In all, **Hintz** has registered 11 points (7-4-11) in 13 career games against Vancouver.
- Among active Stars, Jamie Benn ranks first in goals (17) and in points (17-19—36) and is third in assists (19) in 43 career
 games against the Canucks. He also is first in game-winning goals (5) against them.
- **Jason Robertson** rides a four-game point streak against Vancouver heading into tonight's matchup, totaling eight points (4-4—8) in those games. In all, **Robertson** has 10 points (4-6—10) in 11 career games against the Canucks.
- Mikael Granlund enters tonight's contest riding a six-game point streak (4-4—8) against Vancouver dating back to Nov. 20, 2023. Granlund has registered 32 points (10-22—32) in 34 career games played against the Canucks.
- Mikko Rantanen enters tonight's game riding an eight-game point streak against the Canucks, earning 12 points (7-5—12) during that span. In 20 career games vs. Vancouver, Rantanen has tallied 31 points (15-16—31), earning points in all but three games.
 - His 1.55 points per game average ranks fifth in the league among active skaters who have played Vancouver at least 10 times in their career.
- Thomas Harley enters tonight's contest riding a two-game point streak, earning two points (1-1—2) in those games. In seven career games played vs. Vancouver, **Harley** has tallied four points (2-2—4).
- Cody Ceci rides a two-game point streak against the Canucks, totaling three points (1-2-3) during that span.
- Sam Steel has eight points (8-0-8) in 12 career games vs. Vancouver, including his lone hat trick on March 26, 2019 at Vancouver (w/ Anaheim). Steel has goals in six of his 12 appearances against the Canucks.

BIKER GANG

- Thomas Harley set a career high with his 16th goal of the season in Dallas' last game on April 6 against the Wild. He now has 26 points (9-17—26) in his last 27 games played dating back to Jan. 31, which is tied for fourth on Dallas' roster during that span.
- Harley's assist against Pittsburgh on April 5 was his 33rd assist and 48th point of the season, both of which set career highs for the defenseman.
- Harley's 26 points (9-17—26) since Jan. 31 were the third-most during that span among all NHL defensemen entering play Monday, trailing only Colorado's Cale Makar (35) and Buffalo's Rasmus Dahlin (27).
- Since Jan. 31 Dallas' first game without **Miro Heiskanen Harley** has been averaging 24:59 of ice time per game, which tops all Stars skaters and was tied for ninth in the NHL entering play Monday.
 - o Prior to Jan. 31, **Harley** was averaging 22:27 of ice time per game.
 - Harley skated a career-high 31:11 in Dallas' game on March 20 against the Tampa Bay Lightning. It was the highest time on ice total by a Stars skater in a regular-season game since Heiskanen skated 32:01 on April 11, 2021 against the Nashville Predators.
- In all, **Harley** has totaled 49 points (16-33—49) in 75 regular-season games this season. His 16 goals this season were tied for the fourth-most among all NHL defensemen this season entering play Monday.
 - His 16 goals this year are also tied for the sixth-most by a Stars defenseman in a single season in franchise history.
- If **Harley** were to have at least one more point this season, he would become the third Stars defenseman in the last 10 years to reach the 50-point plateau, joining Miro Heiskanen (2022-23 and 2023-24) and John Klingberg (2015-16 and 2017-18).
- When **Harley** has been on the ice during even-strength play this season, the Stars have outscored their opponents 93-56. His plus-37 on-ice even-strength goal differential was the best mark in the NHL this season entering play Monday.
- Harley recorded the 100th point of his NHL career with an assist in Dallas' March 26 game against the Oilers, making
 him the third defenseman drafted in 2019 to reach the 100-point milestone, joining Detroit's Moritz Seider and Buffalo's
 Bowen Byram. He also became the 24th defenseman in franchise history to total 100 points with the Stars.
- Harley's 100th career point came in his 188th career regular-season games, making him the fourth-fastest defenseman in Stars/North Stars history to record 100 career points according to NHL Stats, following John Klingberg (145 GP), Craig Hartsburg (170 GP) and Brad Maxwell (170 GP).
- Harley matched his single-game career high with three points (1-2—3) in Dallas' March 18 game against the Ducks, surpassing Larry Murphy (93) for the 25th-most points by a defenseman in team history.

- o In that game, the Stars outshot the Ducks 15-2 when **Harley** was on the ice during 5-on-5 play according to Natural Stat Trick.
- Harley's game-winning goal in Dallas' March 22 game against the Flyers came just nine seconds into overtime, which set a record for the quickest overtime goal in franchise history according to NHL Stats.
- Harley is one of four defensemen this season to score two overtime goals. In total, he has scored five overtime goals since the start of 2023-24, which leads all NHL defensemen and is tied for fifth in the NHL.
- Harley's two-goal performance against the Flyers brought his season total up to 15, making him the third defenseman in franchise history to record consecutive 15-goal seasons according to NHL Stats, joining Phillippe Boucher (2 from 2005-06 2006-07) and Lou Nanne (1971-72 1972-73).

HOME COOKING

- The Stars have a 28-8-2 record at home this season. Entering play Monday, they ranked in the top five in the NHL in home wins (tied third), points (fourth) and points percentage (.763, fourth).
- Dallas is one home win shy of matching the franchise record of 29 set by the team in 1998-99.
- Since Jan. 24, the Stars have gone 14-for-40 on the power play at the American Airlines Center. Their 35.0 percent success rate on the power play at home was the third-best mark in the NHL during that span, and their 14 home power-play goals were tied for second entering play Monday.
- Jason Robertson (41 points, 38 games played) and Roope Hintz (39 points, 36 games played) are both playing at a
 point-per-game pace at home this year.
 - o Robertson's 41 home points this year are the most of any Stars skater this season.
- Wyatt Johnston has been playing at a point-per-game pace at home since Oct. 27, totaling 33 points (16-17—33) in 33 games.
- Thomas Harley has recorded 20 points (6-14—20) in his last 19 home games dating back to Dec. 31. His 20 home points
 during that span were tied for fourth and fifth, respectively, on the Stars and among all NHL defensemen entering play
 Monday.
 - o Fifteen of those 20 points have come in the 11 home games that he has played since Feb. 2.
 - He has 28 home points (9-19-28) in all this season, which ranked 10th among NHL defensemen entering play Monday.
- Matt Duchene has tallied 20 points (4-16—20) in his last 18 home games and enters today's game riding a seven-game home point streak. A goal or an assist tonight would give him points in eight consecutive home games for the first time since March 8 to April 5, 2022 while he was playing for the Nashville Predators.
- **Jake Oettinger** has won the last nine games that he has played at the American Airlines Center dating back to Jan. 24, posting a .927 save percentage, a 2.09 goals-against average and one shutout in those games.
 - o Oettinger's current nine-game home win streak is the longest such streak of his career.

DOUBLE DUTCH

- Matt Duchene enters tonight's game riding a six-game point streak, recording eight points (2-6—8) during that span. It is his second six-game point streak of the season.
- Entering play Monday, **Duchene's** six-game run was tied for the fifth-longest active point streak in the NHL. If he were to have a goal or an assist tonight, it would give him points in seven consecutive games for the first time since he had a point in eight straight games to conclude the 2021-22 regular season from April 16 to 29, 2022.
 - A point tonight would also make Duchene the third Stars skater this season to have a point streak of at least seven games, joining Wyatt Johnston (9; 2/8/25 to 3/8/25) and Jason Robertson (8; 2/23/25 to 3/9/25).
- In all, **Duchene** has 79 points (29-50—79) in 77 games this year, which makes the 2024-25 campaign the second-highest scoring season of his 16-year career, trailing only the 86 points he had with Nashville in 2021-22.
- **Duchene's** second assist in Dallas' April 3 game against the Predators was his 48th assist of the season, which set a career high for the forward.

DADDY ISSUES

- Evgenii Dadonov scored the second hat trick of his career with three goals against the Penguins in Dallas' April 5 game.
 Dadonov's first career hat trick also came against Pittsburgh on Feb. 24, 2018.
 - o It made him the third Stars skater to score a hat trick this season, joining **Wyatt Johnston** and **Jason Robertson** who have each scored two hat tricks this year.
- Dadonov's third goal of the day was his 19th of the season, which makes 2024-25 the fifth-highest ranking season of his career in terms of goal scoring.
 - o **Dadonov's** next goal will give him his fifth career 20-goal season.
- **Dadonov** is the sixth-oldest player this season to score at least 19 goals this year, joining Alex Ovechkin (42), Sidney Crosby (30), Anze Kopitar (19), Brad Marchand (21) and Patrick Kane (20).
- Dadonov enters tonight's game one point shy of recording the fifth 40-point season of his career.

- Roope Hintz was named the NHL's Second Star of the Week for the week ending on March 30 after tallying nine points (2-7—9) in four games played.
- It is the third time in his career that he has earned Star of the Week honors after previously being named the NHL's Third Star of the Week on April 12, 2021 and the Second Star of the Week on March 3, 2025.
- Hintz is one of 10 players this season to earn Star of the Week honors on multiple occasions.
- Hintz joins Matt Duchene (week ending on Oct. 27, 2024) and Mason Marchment (week ending on Nov. 17, 2024) as the three Dallas players to earn Star of the Week honors this season.
- **Hintz** has totaled 29 points (6-23—29) in 20 games played since the Four Nation Break. Since Feb. 22, his 23 assists were the second-most in the NHL entering play Monday and his 29 points were tied for fourth.
- According to Natural Stat Trick, when Hintz has been on the ice during 5-on-5 play since Feb. 22, the Stars have
 outscored their opponents 16-7.
- Hintz recorded his 200th career assist in Dallas' March 29 game against Seattle. With the assist he became...
 - o The 28th skater in franchise history to total 200 assists with the team.
 - o The 18th skater selected in the 2015 NHL Draft to reach the 200-assist milestone.
 - o The 30th Finnish player in NHL history to have 200 career assists.
- In all this season, **Hintz** has totaled 65 points (28-37—65) in 71 regular-season games, making the 2024-25 campaign his fourth consecutive 60-point season.

THIRTY, FLIRTY AND THRIVING

- The Stars enter tonight's game with three players that have scored at least 30 goals this season: **Jason Robertson** (33), **Mikko Rantanen** (31) and **Wyatt Johnston** (30).
- Entering play Monday, the Stars were one of four teams this season to have at least three 30-goal scorers on its roster, joining the Tampa Bay Lightning (4), Toronto Maple Leafs (3) and the Washington Capitals (3).
- Entering today's game, **Matt Duchene** and **Roope Hintz** are one and three goals shy, respectively, of reaching the 30-goal mark. If they were both to score 30 goals by the end of the regular season, it would mark the first time in franchise history that the Stars would have five 30-goals scorers on its roster.
- Additionally, the Stars could become the first team to have five 30-goal scorers on its roster since the Pittsburgh Penguins and Detroit Red Wings, who both did so during the 1992-93 season according to NHL Stats. Please note that this includes players who did not score all 30+ of their goals with one team.

IT TAKES TWO

- **Jake Oettinger** has an 20-6-3 record in his last 29 games played dating back to Dec. 29, posting a .916 save percentage and a 2.47 goals-against average during that span.
 - o His 20 wins since Dec. 29 were tied for the most in the NHL during that span entering play Monday.
- **Oettinger** made a season-high 41 saves in Dallas' March 26 game, a 4-3 win over the Oilers. The Stars were outshot 44-24 in that game.
- Oettinger made 33 saves for his 12th career shutout in Dallas' March 24 game, a 3-0 win over Minnesota, which tied Jon Casev for the sixth-most shutouts in franchise history.
 - o **Oettinger** saved 5.74 goals above expected in the game according to MoneyPuck.com.
- Oettinger's shutout was also the 12th of his career, which tied teammate Casey DeSmith for the fifth-most by a U.S.-born goaltender in NHL history according to NHL Stats.
- The Stars' victory over the Wild was also the 146th win of **Oettinger's** career, which passed Cesare Maniago (145) for the fourth-most wins by a goaltender in franchise history.
- Oettinger earned his 30th win of the season in Dallas' game on March 6, a 3-2 overtime win over the Calgary Flames. According to NHL Stats, he became the fourth goaltender in Stars/North Stars history with four or more 30-win seasons, joining Marty Turco (6x), Ed Belfour (4x) and Kari Lehtonen (4x). He also joined Turco (6 from 2002-03 to 2008-09) and Belfour (4 from 1997-98 to 2000-01) as the only netminders to do so in four consecutive campaigns with the franchise.
- Casey DeSmith has posted an 8-1-1 record in his last nine games played dating back to Jan. 25 against the St. Louis Blues, posting a .937 save percentage and a 2.09 goals-against average in those contests.
 - Among netminders that have played at least five games since Jan. 25, **DeSmith** ranked second and tied for ninth, respectively, in the NHL in save percentage and goals-against average.
- **DeSmith** made 46 saves in Dallas' March 27 game against the Flames, a 5-2 Stars win. His 46 saves were the most by a Dallas netminder this season and the third-most in a single game in **DeSmith's** career.
- In all this season, **DeSmith** has saved .731 goals above expected per 60, which was the best mark in the NHL this season entering play Monday among netminders that have played in more than five games.
- In all, **Oettinger** and **DeSmith** have combined for a .911 save percentage this season, which was the second-best mark of any team in the NHL this season entering play Monday. The duo's 2.53 goals-against average this season ranked third in the NHL this year entering play Monday.

KILLING IT

- The Stars have had an 84.4 percent success rate on the penalty kill this season, which was the second-best mark in the NHL this year entering play Monday, trailing only the Carolina Hurricanes (84.8 percent).
- No team in the league this season has allowed fewer power-play goals against than the Stars' 33, and their -27 goal differential on the penalty kill this year was tied for the third-best mark in the NHL entering play Monday.
- If the Stars maintain this pace, it would make the 2024-25 season their best on the penalty kill since 2007-08, when the team finished the season with an 85.6 percent success rate on the penalty kill.
- The Stars are also one of the least-penalized teams in the league, ranking 27th in the league in both total penalty minutes (533; tied) and penalty minutes per game (6:55) entering play Monday.
- Entering play Monday, **Esa Lindell** was leading all NHL skaters in both total shorthanded ice time (276:23) and shorthanded ice time per game (3:35) this season.
 - Lindell had played 20 more minutes of shorthanded ice time than the second ranked player (Mike Matheson;
 257:25) entering play Monday.
