THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW

The Sabres have won three of their last four games against the Flames in Calgary (3-1-0).

In his last nine games, **Jason Zucker** has posted 10 points (5+5).



Zucker has recorded nine points (5+4) in eight games since returning from an illness on Nov. 21.

Zucker has scored one goal in three consecutive games and a goal tonight would give him his fifth goal streak of four or more games in his career.

He last recorded a streak of four or more games from Dec. 29, 2024 to Jan. 4, 2025 (4 games; 6+2).

Josh Norris has posted five points (2+3) in three games since returning from injury on Dec. 1 vs. Winnipeg, including at least one point in each of those games.

A point tonight would give Norris his first point streak of four or more games since Dec. 15 to 23, 2023 (5 games; 5+2).

In his career, **Norris** (five points in his first four games of 2025-26) has never recorded six or more points in his first five games of any season.

Josh Doan has notched four points (1+3) in his last four games.

On Dec. 3 at Philadelphia, **Rasmus Dahlin** surpassed Henrik Tallinder (532 games played with Buffalo) and gained sole possession of 11th place on Buffalo's all-time list for games played by a defenseman.

Dahlin is five games away from surpassing Jerry Korab (537 games played; 10th all-time) and moving into the top 10 on Buffalo's all-time list.

Buffalo ranks first among all NHL teams in penalty-kill percentage (87.2).

The Sabres have allowed the fewest power-play goals in the NHL this season (10).

ON THIS DATE

The Sabres are 10-6-5 all-time on December 8.

December 8, 1995: Jim Schoenfeld is inducted into the Sabres Hall of Fame before the Sabres and the Schoenfeld-coached Washington Capitals battle to a 2-2 tie.

December 8, 2005: Jason Pominville records two assists and Maxim Afinogenov scores in overtime as Buffalo defeats Anaheim 3-2.

RING OF FIRE


The Sabres are averaging 3.38 goals per game against Calgary all-time, the fifth-highest goals per game average Buffalo has posted against any active team.

Tage Thompson is riding an eight-game point streak against the Flames and he has posted nine points (7+2) in that span.

With a point tonight, **Thompson** would match the longest point streak by a Sabres skater against the Flames in franchise history (Gilbert Perreault; 9 games; Feb. 12, 1983 to Oct. 30, 1985; 9+10).

Mattias Samuelsson has recorded two points in each of his last two games against Calgary (2+2).

Rasmus Dahlin has registered seven points (1+6) in his last seven games against the Flames.
