



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Does my child need to know how to skate? What skill level does my child need to have?

Nashville Predators Hockey Schools are open to all Youth House League & Youth Travel Hockey goaltenders. All goaltenders should know how to skate and must have had at least one season of House League under their belt before this camp.

What equipment does my child need? Is rental equipment available?

All goaltenders will need to provide his/her own hockey equipment to participate. We are unable to provide rental equipment or skates. Necessary equipment includes a mask (HECC Approved), Neck Guard/Dangler, Glove & Blocker, Chest & Arms, Stick, Pants, Knee & Thigh Guards, Leg Pads, Skates and a mouthguard. If you are looking to buy equipment locally, we suggest Perani's Hockey World located inside the Ford Ice Centers at 5264 Hickory Hollow Parkway, Antioch, TN 37013 or 7638 B Hwy 70 S, Nashville, TN 37221 or area Play It Again Sports locations.

Who are the instructors at Nashville Predators Goaltending Camp?

Nashville Predators Goaltending Camp will be led by qualified instructors that will include Nashville Predators Youth Hockey Development staff, Nashville area hockey coaches and members of the community with backgrounds in semi-pro and/or college hockey.

What is the cost for the Nashville Predators Goaltending Camp?

The cost for Nashville Predators Goaltending Camp is \$600.

Are there any discounts for Nashville Predators Goaltending Camp & Hockey School?

Goalies that register for the Nashville Predators Goaltending Camp from July 26-30, 2021 will receive a \$300 discount to Hockey School. ***To register with the goalie discount, please contact (615) 770-2152.***

Do we allow payment plans for Nashville Predators Goaltending Camp?

Yes, we allow payment plans of 2 payments to complete the cost of registration. Half is due when registration is started and the remaining balance is due one month after the original payment/registration date. ***To set up a payment plan, please contact 615-770-2152.***

What is included with registration?

Participants will receive an official Nashville Predators Goaltending Camp jersey, Dri-Fit shirt, commemorative photo, Development Report Card, and more. Participants will also receive a daily lunch.

What is the cancelation policy?

The Nashville Predators Goaltending Camp has a **NO REFUND** policy. In the event of documented medical issue we will provide a full refund less a \$50 fee. All other refund requests will be handled on a case-by-case basis and may be subject to a partial refund.

How many registrations are accepted for Hockey School?

Nashville Predators Goaltending Camp will accept 20 goaltenders for each group, Saros Group (6-10 years old), Rinne Group (11-17 years old). Participants will be grouped according to ability on the ice to enhance their learning environment.

Does the Nashville Predators Goaltending Camp sell out? Is a waitlist offered?

Yes! Once the camp sells out, we will begin a waitlist. As we are notified of cancelations, we will contact families for the opportunity to register - first come, first serve.

Once I register my child for the Nashville Predators Goaltending Camp, what will happen next?

Once your registration and full payment is processed you will receive a confirmation e-mail with more information. We will send an orientation packet with some paperwork that needs to be completed prior to camp.

What does my child need to bring to Nashville Predators Goaltending Camp?

In addition to hockey equipment, participants should also bring: a change of clothes for dryland training including sneakers, hat and sunscreen for outdoor activities, a change of clothes to wear under hockey equipment, and nutritious (no candies) snacks throughout the day.

Will there be an orientation for parents? Is any paperwork needed to participate?

We will not hold a formal orientation for parents. Staff will be visible and on-hand the first day of each camp and throughout the week for questions. On the first day of each school campers will check-in to pick up their jersey and t-shirt and to meet instructors.

All participants will receive an orientation packet via email with paperwork that will have to be filled out and sent back prior to camp.
