



SCORE FOR THE TREES



The Pittsburgh Penguins have partnered with The Davey Tree Expert Company for a new community initiative to help restore and protect the urban forest in Pittsburgh.

Through the “Score for the Trees” program, the two organizations have agreed to plant one tree in the greater Pittsburgh area for every goal scored by a Penguins player at PPG Paints Arena during the 2022-23 regular season.

142 GOALS = 142 TREES

Season one of the Score for the Trees program brought in **142 goals, meaning 142 trees will be planted!** These trees will be planted starting in April 2023 and continue throughout the summer and fall all over the Pittsburgh region, including areas near PPG Paints Arena and the Hunt Armory Ice Rink in Shadyside.
